## KESWICK THEOLOGY: A SURVEY AND ANALYSIS OF THE DOCTRINE OF SANCTIFICATION IN THE EARLY KESWICK MOVEMENT<sup>1</sup>

Large swaths of modern fundamentalism and evangelicalism chronologically separate the point when believers (1) first experience justification and (2) begin progressive sanctification. This is evident, for example, in the way many believers share their salvation testimony: "I was saved when I was eight years old, and I surrendered to Christ when I was twelve." Or, "I accepted Christ as my Savior when I was eight years old, and I accepted Christ as my Lord when I was twelve." This state of affairs reflects the influence of Keswick<sup>3</sup> theology.

Keswick is a small town in the scenic Lake District of northwest England. Since 1875, it has hosted a weeklong meeting in July for the Keswick Convention. In this essay "the early Keswick movement" refers to a movement from 1875 to 1920 that was (1) conservatively evangelical; (2) based on and distinguished by the belief that the majority
