For the students who are not as quick to understand, we can go over it and keep going over it. Repetition should help. <p>Advanced Students:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> For students who understand or master the lesson concepts more quickly than expected, they can then break 100 into 5s or 20s.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> We will sit in a circle on the carpet and count to 10 (using pieces of bouncy balls or something to gain attention). Then I will fill out the grid to 100 while showing the children on a projector. With the projector still on, have the students fill out one for themselves while I walk around and make sure they understand. Now introduce the concept of counting objects and how every time we go up a number that means we add another object to the section. Model the skill up to 20. Give each child the same amount of blocks and count them all together. Now take some from some student and give some to others (no more than 20) have them count them. I will walk around with a clipboard and assess where they are. Time for any questions. Give a homework sheet that has different pictures on it that they need to count.
