Madison's argument that the range of perspectives and interests found in state policymaking will be considerably narrower than in Washington she analyzes the influence of interest groups and other key actors in the legislative process at both the state and national levels. She compares the legislative process during the 104th Congress 1995-96 with that in three states: Maryland, Texas, and North Dakota, and finds that the debates in the states saw a more limited range of participants with fewer of them representing poor people and fewer competing ideas. The welfare reform bill of 1996 comes up for renewal in 2002. At stake in the U.S. experiment in welfare reform are principles of equal opportunity, fairness, and self-determination as well as long-term concerns for political and social stability.
