flamboyant heroines but were not identified as Alcott's work until the 1940s. Fame and success came unexpectedly in 1868. When a publisher suggested she write a girl's book, she drew on her memories of her childhood and wrote *Little Women*, depicting herself as Jo March while her sisters Anna, Abby May, and Elizabeth became Meg, Amy, and Beth. She re-created the high spirits of the Alcott girls and took many incidents from life but made the March family financially comfortable as the Alcotts never had been. *Little Women* to its author's surprise struck a cord in America's largely female reading public and became a huge success. Louisa was prevailed upon to continue the story which she did in *Little Men* 1871 and *Jo's Boys* 1886. In 1873 she published *Work: A Story of Experience*, an autobiography in fictional disguise with an all too appropriate title. Now a famous writer, she continued to turn out novels and stories and to work for the women's suffrage and temperance movements as her father had worked for the abolitionists. Bronson Alcott and Louisa May Alcott both died in Boston in the same month, March.
