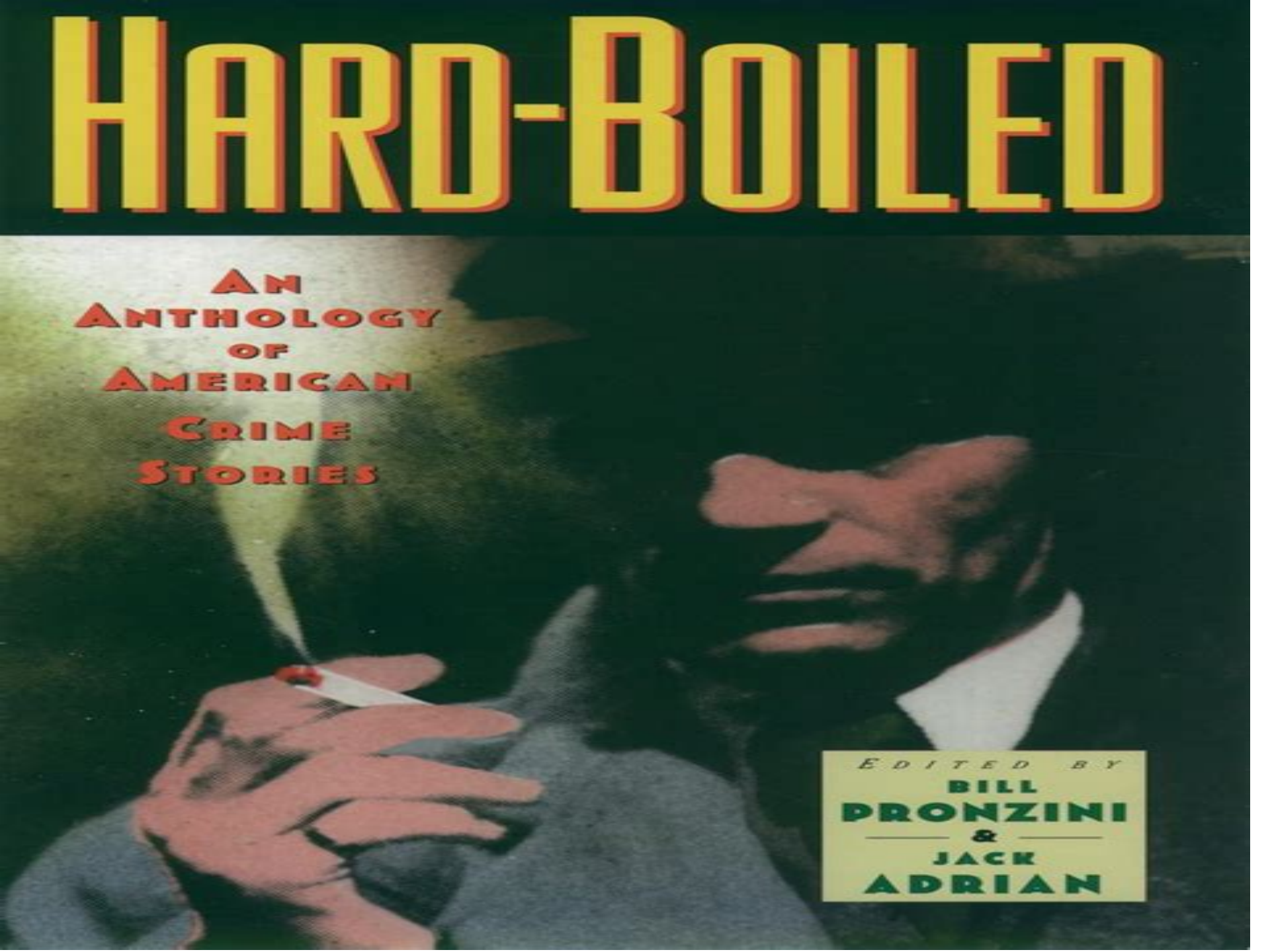

Hardboiled Bill Pronzini, Jack Adrian, 1997-05-29 What are the ingredients of a hard boiled detective story Savagery style sophistication sleuthing and sex said Ellery Queen Often a desperate blond a jealous husband and of course a tough but tender P I the likes of Sam Spade or Philip Marlowe Perhaps Raymond Chandler summed it up best in his description of Dashiell Hammett's style Hammett gave murder back to the kind of people that commit it He put these people down on paper as they were and he made them talk and think in the language they customarily used for these purposes *Hard Boiled An Anthology of American Crime Stories* is the largest and most comprehensive collection of its kind with over half of the stories never published before in book form Included are thirty six sublimely suspenseful stories that chronicle the evolution of this quintessentially American art form from its earliest beginnings during the Golden Age of the legendary pulp magazine *Black Mask* in the 1920s to the arrival of the tough digest *Manhunt* in the 1950s and finally leading up to present day hard boiled stories by such writers as James Ellroy Here are eight decades worth of the best writing about betrayal murder and mayhem from Hammett's 1925 tour de force *The Scorched Face* in which the disappearance of two sisters leads Hammett's never named detective the Continental Op straight into a web of sexual blackmail amidst the West Coast elite to Ed Gorman's 1992 *The Long Silence* After a gripping and powerful rendezvous involving a middle class insurance executive a Chicago streetwalker and a loaded 38 Other delectable contributions include *Brush Fire* by James M Cain author of *The Postman Always Rings Twice* Raymond Chandler's *I'll Be Waiting* where for once the femme fatale is not blond but a redhead a Ross Macdonald mystery starring Macdonald's most famous creation the cryptic Lew Archer and *The Screen Test* of Mike Hammer by the one and only Micky Spillane The hard boiled cult has more in common with the legendary lawmen of the Wild West than with the gentleman and lady sleuths of traditional drawing room mysteries and this direct line of descent is on brilliant display in two of the most subtle and tautly written stories in the collection Elmore Leonard's *3 10 to Yuma* and John D MacDonald's *Nor Iron Bars* Other contributors include Evan Hunter better known as Ed McBain Jim Thompson Helen Nielsen Margaret Maron Andrew Vachss Faye Kellerman and Lawrence Sanders Compellingly and compulsively readable *Hard Boiled An Anthology of American Crime Stories* is a page turner no mystery lover will want to be without Containing many notable rarities it celebrates a genre that has profoundly shaped not only American literature and film but how we see our heroes and ourselves

Creatures of Darkness Gene D. Phillips, 2021-03-17 An exhaustively researched survey of Raymond Chandler's thorny relationship with Hollywood during the classic period of film noir Alain Silver film producer and author Raymond Chandler's seven novels including *The Big Sleep* 1939 and *The Long Goodbye* 1953 with their pessimism and grim realism had a direct influence on the emergence of film noir Chandler worked

to give his crime novels the flavor of his adopted city Los Angeles which was still something of a frontier town rife with corruption and lawlessness In addition to novels Chandler wrote short stories and penned the screenplays for several films including *Double Indemnity* 1944 and *Strangers on a Train* 1951 His work with Billy Wilder and Alfred Hitchcock on these projects was fraught with the difficulties of collaboration between established directors and an author who disliked having to edit his writing on demand *Creatures of Darkness* is the first major biocritical study of Chandler in twenty years Gene Phillips explores Chandler's unpublished script for *Lady in the Lake* examines the process of adaptation of the novel *Strangers on a Train* discusses the merits of the unproduced screenplay for *Playback* and compares Howard Hawks's director's cut of *The Big Sleep* with the version shown in theaters Through interviews he conducted with Wilder Hitchcock Hawks and Edward Dmytryk over the past several decades Phillips provides deeper insight into Chandler's sometimes difficult personality Chandler's wisecracking private eye Philip Marlowe has spawned a thousand imitations *Creatures of Darkness* lucidly explains the author's dramatic impact on both the literary and cinematic worlds demonstrating the immeasurable debt that both detective fiction and the neo noir films of today owe to Chandler's stark vision *Hollywood Riots* Doug Dibbern, 2015-12-17 The large literature about the politics of Hollywood in the period of McCarthy and the blacklist has largely overlooked political filmmaking during those agitated years *Hollywood Riots* examines the most vibrant cycle of independently produced political films made while House Committee on Un American Activities was investigating communists in the film industry In doing so it shifts the focus from the politics of Washington to the politics of Los Angeles and from the films of the Hollywood Ten to the more politically complex films of the progressive community at large Dibbern shows how the movies produced by progressives at the end of the 1950s including *The Lawless* *The Sound of Fury* *The Underworld* were the logical cinematic parallel to their political and journalistic advocacy fighting the conservative newspapers In these films they were recasting political events from California's recent past as politically engaged narratives that were inflected with their own fears of persecution *Hollywood Riots* re views the work of notable directors like Joseph Losey and Cy Endfield as well as introducing unheralded political screenwriters and directors such as Daniel Mainwaring Jo Pagano and Leo C Popkin *The Noir Thriller* Lee Horsley, 2016-01-03 What is literary noir How do British and American noir thrillers relate to their historical contexts In considering such questions this study ranges over hundreds of novels analysing the politics and poetics of noir from the hard boiled fiction of Hammett Chandler and Cain to the exciting diversity of nineties thrillers with sections on the tough investigators gangsters and victims of the Depression years the first person killers femmes fatales and black protagonists of mid century the game players voyeurs and consumers of contemporary thrillers and future noir *Mean Streets and Raging Bulls* Richard Martin, 2000-01-01 Classic film noir was Hollywood's dark cinema of crime and corruption a genre underpinned by a tone of existential cynicism which stripped bare the myth of the American Dream and offered a bleak nightmarish vision of a fragmented society that rhymed with many of the social
