sentry dogs used to safeguard critical installations such as ports and airfields A new dimension in canine utilization was realized when marijuana detector dog teams were trained and deployed to assist military police in suppressing illicit drug traffic Sentry and marijuana detector dog teams were then deployed worldwide in support of military police An important outgrowth of the conflict was the development of canine research and development efforts These ongoing efforts were able to initiate the first steps toward developing a more intelligent and stronger military dog training dogs to detect specific drugs and explosives developing multiple purpose dogs and employing tactical dogs by electronic remote control In the 1990s and early 2000s MWDs were deployed around the globe in military operations such as Just Cause Desert Shield and Desert Storm Uphold Democracy and Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom These teams were effectively utilized to enhance the security of critical facilities and areas as well as bolster force protection and antiterrorism missions allowing commanders to use military police
