Severe damage to canola plants can be caused by overwintering populations of flea beetles feeding on newly emerged seedlings. Cabbage seed pod weevil *Ceutorhynchus obstrictus*, swede midge *Contarinia nasturtii* and tarnished plant bug *Lygus lineolaris* are also severe pests on canola. Minor pests include aphids, cabbage aphid *Brevicoryne brassicae* and turnip aphid *Hyadaphis erysimi* and grasshopper *Melanoplus sanguinipes*.
