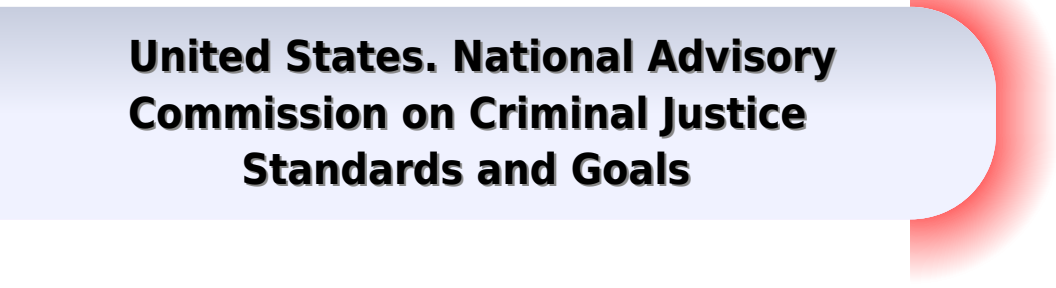

Hoover, Vladimir Sergevnnin, 2007 The Ghostbusters refrain Who you gonna call typically connotes a lighthearted response to an unusual problem but in the context of a human being suffering a mental health crisis the refrain is anything but lighthearted In an ideal world who you gonna call would be a trained mental health professional In the real world the cry for help is usually received by the police Police respond because there is no one else to assist Police officers rank mental health crisis situations as far more stressful than crimes in progress A person suffering from mental illness is by definition not fully rational Although they are likewise not fully irrational behavior is unpredictable and unpredictable behavior for the police is potentially dangerous behavior As a consequence outcomes of engagement between law enforcement and mental health consumers are too often tragic No organization is more concerned about inadequate response than the police themselves

Improving Police Response to Mental Illness provides best practices guidance. A national pool of experts provide both insight and recommendations ranging from the conceptual Atypical Situations Atypical Responses to the pragmatic Law Enforcement Training Models. Police Selection and Training J.C. Yuille, 2012-12-06. The New Police Officer. During the past twenty years the tasks required of police officers have expanded and changed with dramatic rapidity. The traditional roles of the police had been those of law enforcement and the maintenance of public order. As a consequence police officers were typically large bodied males selected for their physical abilities and trained to accept orders and enforce the law. Over the past two decades however the industrialized nations have placed a variety of new demands on police officers. To traditional law enforcement and public order tasks have been added social work mental health duties and community relations work. For example domestic disputes violence between husbands and wives lovers relatives etc have increased in frequency and severity or at least there has been a dramatic increase in reporting the occurrence of domestic violence. Our societies have no formal system to deal with domestic disputes and the responsibility to do so in most countries has fallen to the police. In fact in some areas as many as 60% of calls for service to the police are related to domestic disputes. See the chapter in this text by Dutton. As a result the police officer has had to become a skilled social worker able to intervene with sensitivity in domestic situations. Alternatively in the case of West Germany the officer has had to learn to work cooperatively with social workers. See the chapter by Steinhilper.

A major restructuring and streamlining of procedures and practices in processing criminal cases at state and local levels is proposed by the National Advisory Commission on Criminal Justice Standards and Goals. The proposals of the Commission appear in the form of specific standards and recommendations, almost 100 in all, that spell out in detail where, why, how, and what improvements can and should be made in the judicial segment of the criminal justice system. The report on courts is a reference work for the practitioner, judge, court administrator, prosecutor, or defender, as well as the interested layman. The Commission argues that the problems which keep the criminal court system from performing its functions are inconsistency in the processing of criminal defendants, uncertainty concerning results, unacceptable delays, and alienation of the community. In composing suggested improvements for the court system, the Commission's first priority is to devise standards for attaining speed and efficiency in the pretrial and trial processes and prompt finality in appellate proceedings. The second priority is the upgrading of defense and prosecution functions, and the third priority is the assurance of a high quality in the judiciary. To expedite pretrial procedures, the prosecutor should screen all criminal cases coming before him and divert from the system all cases wherein further processing by the prosecutor is not appropriate. Among Commission recommendations are elimination of all but the investigative function of the grand jury, elimination of formal arraignment, unification of all courts within each state, and the upgrading of criminal court personnel.
