long struggle to save the Manor ensued finally ending with compulsory purchase in 2013 Although manor houses occur in most English parishes they have received surprisingly little archaeological study Every year hundreds are restored or altered but rarely accompanied by detailed recording or scholarly research and popular television programs reveal the shameful level of destruction that takes place in the name of restoration This is a book like no other the holistic approach to the rehabilitation of Northwold's derelict manor house involving history archaeology architecture and genealogy demonstrates how much can be learned about a building that had never before been studied The project has received several awards
