The Politics of Media Scarcity Greg Elmer, Stephen J. Neville, 2024-01-31 This book questions the predominance of media abundance as a guiding concept for contemporary mediated politics. The authors argue that media abundance is not a universal condition and that certain individuals, communities, and even nations can more accurately be referred to as media scarce where access to media technologies and content is limited, highly controlled, or surveilled. Through case studies that focus on guerilla militants, incarcerated Indigenous people, and cold war era infrastructure including Soviet closed or secret cities and Canadian nuclear bunkers, the book's chapters interrogate how the once media scarce later speak to and can be heard by the predominant abundant media culture. Drawing from several art projects and diverse cultural sites, the book highlights how media scarce communities negotiate and otherwise narrate their place in the world, their past experiences and lives, and escape from subjugation. To better understand media scarce politics, the book asks how and when communities become by accident or force by choice or necessity media scarce. This innovative and insightful text will appeal to students and scholars around the world working in the areas of media and politics, art and politics, visual studies, surveillance studies, and communication studies.

Ruth First and Joe Slovo in the War Against Apartheid Alan Wieder, 2013-07-01 Ruth First and Joe Slovo, husband and wife, were leaders of the war to end apartheid in South Africa. Communists, scholars, parents, and uncompromising militants, they were the perfect enemies for the white police state. Together, they were swept up in the growing resistance to apartheid and together they experienced repression and exile. Their contributions to the liberation struggle as individuals and as a couple are undeniable. Academia and its citizens during periods of political violence and social conflict are often overlooked. When attention is given, the focus tends to be on student activism, access to higher education, or curriculum development. The experiences of academics affected by conflict remain under-researched despite the crucial role they play as educators and in generating, documenting, preserving, and challenging knowledges. This is particularly concerning given that academics have and continue to be at risk as targets of sanction, persecution, and oppression. This edited volume seeks to address this gap by exploring and evoking the complexities of academic subjectivity, place, and practice in contexts where intellectual and state authority are contested or in transition. It features contributions by academics, artists, and memory activists who have stepped bravely outside of the parameters of their disciplines with modes of enquiry and representation that include conversations, vignettes, and case studies, critical ethnographies, oral life histories, interviews, poetry, and collage. Understanding Non-State Actors Eran Zohar,2023-10-24 Understanding Non State Actors aims to reduce the scarcity of academic literature on armed non state actors NSAs that have always been a part of world politics and wars This monograph offers possibly for the first time a systematic historical review as well as a substantive theory of NSAs and their arming efforts The world has been astonished by the ability of the well armed Hamas to inflict heavy losses on the powerful Israel Thus from the Jewish rebellion against Rome to the war between the Ukrainian separatists and the Ukrainian government NSAs weapons acquisition has been vital for the build up of their force enabling both the employment of that force and its sustainability While weapons are not necessarily the most important factor in military build up NSAs need weapons to fight and revolts usually erupt after the organizers have acquired a certain number of weapons Conversely many revolts lose momentum and operations are not carried out or turn ineffective due to shortages of arms and ammunition A major theme of this monograph is that in spite of dramatic political and technological changes armed NSAs in different periods have employed similar methods to acquire weapons Self production looting and stealing external support and the arms trade were always the major ways for NSAs to acquire weapons though the importance of each method and the type of arms has changed remarkably over time Understanding Non State Actors discusses the factors political social cultural technological and organizational that have both facilitated and constrained the ability of NSAs to acquire arms Especially lecturers and students of Military Terrorism Conflict studies War and peace studies will benefit from this study
