

Many Minds, One Heart Wesley C. Hogan, 2013-01-22 How did the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee break open the caste system in the American South between 1960 and 1965 In this innovative study Wesley Hogan explores what SNCC accomplished and more important how it fostered significant social change in such a short time She offers new insights into the internal dynamics of SNCC as well as the workings of the larger civil rights and Black Power movement of which it was a part As Hogan chronicles the members of SNCC created some of the civil rights movement s boldest experiments in freedom including the sit ins of 1960 the rejuvenated Freedom Rides of 1961 and grassroots democracy projects in Georgia and Mississippi She highlights several key players including Charles Sherrod Bob Moses and Fannie Lou Hamer as innovators of grassroots activism and democratic practice Breaking new ground Hogan shows how SNCC laid the foundation for the emergence of the New Left and created new definitions of political leadership during the civil rights and Vietnam eras She traces the ways other social movements such as Black Power women s liberation and the antiwar movement adapted practices developed within SNCC to apply to their particular causes Many Minds One Heart ultimately reframes the movement and asks us to look anew at where America stands on justice and equality today Roots of the Civil Rights Movement Sean Chabot, 2012-01-01 This book explores collective learning in the Gandhian repertoire's transnational diffusion from the Indian independence movement to the American civil rights movement Instead of focusing primarily on interpersonal linkages or causal mechanisms it highlights how decades of translation and experimentation by various actors enabled full implementation It also shows that transnational diffusion was not a linear and predictable process but underwent numerous twists and turns It is relevant for contemporary scholars as well as activists

Uncertain Refuge Elizabeth Allen,2021-10-22 To seek sanctuary from persecution by entering a sacred space is an act of desperation but also a symbolic endeavor fugitives invoke divine presence to reach a precarious safe haven that imbues their lives with religious social or political significance In medieval England sanctuary was upheld under both canon and common law and up to five hundred people sought sanctuary every year What they found however was not so much a static refuge as a temporary respite from further action confession and exile or from further violence jurisdictional conflict harrying or starvation a breaching of the sanctuary While sanctuary has usually been analyzed as part of legal history in Uncertain Refuge Elizabeth Allen explores the symbolic consequences of sanctuary seeking in English literary works miracle collections chronicles romances and drama She ponders the miracle of a stag s escape from the hunt into a churchyard as well as the account of a fallen political favorite who gains a sort of charisma as he takes sanctuary three times in succession the figure of Sir Gawain seeking refuge in a stark land far from the court and Robin Hood hiding in his local forest refuge among his Merry Men Her consideration of medieval sanctuary extends to its resonances in a seventeenth century play about the early Tudor usurper Perkin Warbeck and even into modern America with the case of a breach of sanctuary in southwest Georgia in

1963 when sheriffs took over a voter registration meeting in a local church Uncertain Refuge illuminates a fantasy of protection and its impermanence that animated late medieval literary culture and one that remains poignantly alive if no longer written into law in today s troubled political world Making the Latino South Cecilia Márguez, 2023-08-10 In the 1940s South it seemed that non Black Latino people were on the road to whiteness In fact in many places throughout the region governed by Jim Crow they were able to attend white schools live in white neighborhoods and marry white southerners However by the early 2000s Latino people in the South were routinely cast as illegal aliens and targeted by some of the harshest anti immigrant legislation in the country This book helps explain how race evolved so dramatically for this population over the course of the second half of the twentieth century Cecilia M rquez guides readers through time and place from Washington DC to the deep South tracing how non Black Latino people moved through the region s evolving racial landscape In considering Latino presence in the South's schools its workplaces its tourist destinations and more M rquez tells a challenging story of race making that defies easy narratives of progressive change and promises to reshape the broader American histories of Jim Crow the civil rights movement immigration work and culture Civil Rights History from the Ground Up Emilye Crosby, 2011 After decades of scholarship on the civil rights movement at the local level the insights of bottom up movement history remain essentially invisible in the accepted narrative of the movement and peripheral to debates on how to research document and teach about the movement This collection of original works refocuses attention on this bottom up history and compels a rethinking of what and who we think is central to the movement The essays examine such locales as Sunflower County Mississippi Memphis Tennessee and Wilson North Carolina and engage such issues as nonviolence and self defense the implications of focusing on women in the movement and struggles for freedom beyond voting rights and school desegregation Events and incidents discussed range from the movement's heyday to the present and include the Poor People's Campaign mule train to Washington D C the popular response to the deaths of Rosa Parks and Coretta Scott King and political cartoons addressing Barack Obama's presidential campaign The kinds of scholarship represented here which draw on oral history and activist insights along with traditional sources and which bring the specificity of time and place into dialogue with broad themes and a national context are crucial as we continue to foster scholarly debates evaluate newer conceptual frameworks and replace the superficial narrative that persists in the popular **Rhetorical Criticism** Sonja K. Houck, 2022-06-27 Nearly sixty years after Freedom Summer its events especially the lynching of Andrew Goodman James Chaney and Mickey Schwerner stand out as a critical episode of the civil rights movement The infamous deaths of these activists dominate not just the history but also the public memory of the Mississippi Summer Project Beginning in the late 1970s however movement veterans challenged this central narrative with the shocking claim that during the search for Goodman Chaney and Schwerner the FBI and other law enforcement personnel discovered many unidentified Black bodies in Mississippi s swamps rivers and bayous This claim has evolved in subsequent years as activists journalists filmmakers and scholars have continued to repeat it and the number of supposed Black bodies never identified has grown from five to more than two dozen In Black Bodies in the River Searching for Freedom Summer author Davis W Houck sets out to answer two questions Were Black bodies discovered that summer And why has the shocking claim only grown in the past several decades despite evidence to the contrary In other words what rhetorical work does the Black bodies claim do and with what audiences Houck s story begins in the murky backwaters of the Mississippi River and the discovery of the bodies of Henry Dee and Charles Moore murdered on May 2 1964 by the Ku Klux Klan He pivots next to the Council of Federated Organization's voter registration efforts in Mississippi leading up to Freedom Summer He considers the extent to which violence generally and expectations about interracial violence in particular serve as a critical context for the strategy and rhetoric of the Summer Project Houck then interrogates the unnamed Black bodies claim from a historical and rhetorical perspective illustrating that the historicity of the bodies in question is perhaps less the point than the critique of who we remember from that summer and how we remember them Houck examines how different memory texts filmic landscape presidential speech and museums function both to bolster and question the centrality of murdered white men in the legacy of Freedom Summer
