Guatemala Never Again:

Guatemala, Never Again!, 1999 Available for the first time in English this document presents the testimonies of the victims of Guatemala's 36 year long war When Bishop Juan Gerardi responsible for the Human Rights Office of the Archdiocese of Guatemala ODHAG released this study of human rights abuses in his country on April 24 1998 he was murdered two days later The ODHAG has since accused members of the Armed Forces of being responsible for the crime This is the report of the Recovery of Historic Memory Project of Catholic Church The 6500 personal testimonies which are the basis of the report were collected by 600 specially trained volunteers and accounted for over 55 000 victims of the estimated 150 000 dead and disappeared during the conflict Two thirds of the testimonies were collected in different Mayan languages Twenty five per cent of the victims were children Three quarters of all victims were indigenous 422 massacres are documented Responsibility of 79.3 per cent of violence was identified as falling to the Army while the guerrillas account for 9.3 per cent of the violence recounted **Guatemala, Never Again!** Catholic Institute for International Relations, Latin America Bureau, 1999 As a church we collectively and responsibly assumed the task of breaking the silence that thousands of war victims have kept for years We opened up the possibility for them to talk to have their say to tell their stories of suffering and pain so they might feel liberated from the burden that has been weighing down on them for so many years

Reilly,2008-12-22 This book analyzes the implementation of peace processes in Northern Ireland and Guatemala with emphasis on the role of mid level civil society and religious organizations or the voluntary sector Both countries interrupted years of conflict signed peace accords in 1998 and 1996 respectively and still struggle to make them work Despite very different economic development levels both countries have colonial legacies deep cultural divisions and engaged diaspora They grapple with violence poverty and inequitable distribution of wealth and power While religious differences are a backdrop to violence and reconciliation in both cases insecurity and inequity are the root cause and consequence of these conflicts The book summarizes lessons learned and makes policy recommendations for more civil post conflict societies arguing that similar dynamics fuel sustainable peace building and authentic development

family fled to the United States after his tenth birthday This displacement echoing the displacement of his four grandparents from different corners of the Jewish diaspora to Guatemala gives Halfon like his ancestors before him good reason to consider translation a natural environment for his creative work and for life itself Indeed Halfon s uncanny ability to translate his family s history into fictions that resonate across the globe with readers in Spanish English and several other languages helps explain why he has received numerous prizes in the United States Spain Guatemala and even France some as a Latin American author others as a Latino or Jewish author Marilyn G Miller has written the first study to focus exclusively on this important voice in Jewish Latin American letters Only after returning to Guatemala and regaining his command of Spanish through reading literature did Halfon begin to build his life as a writer and translator Nonetheless the author admits that one thing is stubbornly true and it s this every sentence that I write every verb or adjective that I painstakingly insert or remove every literary thought that I have while writing always begins and ends in English Halfon s translated works are never parallel texts however Thus translation and its side effects foreign words linguistic lacunae multilingual modes of perception offer us crucial keys to understanding the author s fictional world as a vehicle for retelling and surviving Jewish trauma and finding his own particular plurilingual voice
