Studies in Manuscript Illumination, 1200-1400 Lucy Freeman Sandler, 2007-12-31 The author is Helen Gould Sheppard Professor of Art History at New York University Institute of Fine Arts and a leading authority on English medieval manuscript illumination This volume brings together twenty six of Professor Sandler s studies focusing on illustrated manuscripts produced in England in the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries particularly on the illuminated psalters The marginal illustrations in these psalters are a topic of particular interest and there are a number of iconographic studies derived from this material A separate section deals with the illustrated encyclopedias of the period particularly the *Omne bonum*

Medieval Clothing and Textiles Robin Netherton, Gale R. Owen-Crocker, 2008 The best new research on medieval clothing and textiles drawing from a range of disciplines and with a special focus on reconstruction The fourth volume of this landmark series features a special focus on headwear with papers analysing women s turbans in fifteenth century French manuscript paintings the changing meaning of the term *cuff* the spread of wimple from England to Southern Italy and a surviving embroidered linen cap attributed to Saint Birgitta of Sweden Northern European dress and textiles are further explored in papers on archaeological textiles from medieval towns in Finland Norway and Sweden the construction of gowns excavated at Herjolfsnes Greenland and references to scarlet clothing in Icelandic sagas Other papers focus on linen production in medieval Russia and an enigmatic quilt of Henry VIII s that almost certainly arrived in England as part of the dowry of Catherine of Aragon Also included are reviews of recent books on clothing and textiles

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Their Hands Before Our Eyes: A Closer Look at Scribes

M.B. Parkes, 2017-03-02 This new book by Malcolm Parkes makes a fundamental contribution to the history of handwriting. Handwriting is a versatile medium that has always allowed individual scribes the opportunity for self-expression despite the limitations of the pen and the finite number of possible movements. The purpose of this study is to focus on the writing of scribes from late antiquity to the beginning of the sixteenth century and to identify those features which are a scribe's personal contribution to the techniques and art of handwriting. The book opens with three chapters surveying the various environments in which scribes worked in the medieval West. The following five, based on the author's Lyell Lectures at the University of Oxford, then examine different aspects of the subject, starting with the basic processes of handwriting and copying. Next come discussions of developments in rapid handwriting with its consequent influence on new alphabets, on more formal set hands, and on the adaptation of movements of the pen to produce elements of style corresponding to changes in the prevailing sense of decorum. The final chapter looks at the significance of some customized images produced by handwriting on the page. The text is illustrated with 69 plates and accompanied by a glossary of the technical terms applied to handwriting, which in itself makes a significant contribution to the subject.

Poems of Cupid, God of Love

Thelma S. Fenster, Mary Carpenter Erler, 2023-08-21 The lightheartedness of these works both masks and enhances their engagement with provocative issues of continuing interest today: conduct in society, literary practice, and moral praxis; relations between men and women; the value of received wisdom. This volume offers texts of two medieval French poems by Christine de Pizan: the *Epistre au dieu d'amours* and *Dit de la Rose*, together with the first translation of these poems into modern English. The medieval English adaptation of Christine's *Epistre*, Thomas Hoccleve's *The Letter of Cupid*, is likewise presented here and provided with a modern English translation. Finally, an eighteenth-century version of Hoccleve's poem, George Sewall's *The Proclamation of Cupid*, is edited here for the first time. The editions of these poems by Christine last edited a century ago are based on the most recent scholarly findings. The edition of Hoccleve's poem reproduces its authorial punctuation from manuscript for the first time and thus sheds light on the vexed question of fifteenth-century English metrics. The lively modern English translations of both can be used by students, scholars, and the general reader.

English Birth Girdles

Mary Morse, 2024-05-06 In medieval England, women in labor wrapped birth girdles around their abdomens to protect themselves and their unborn children. These parchment or paper rolls replicated the girdle relics of the Virgin Mary and other saints loaned to queens and noblewomen, extending childbirth protection to women of all classes. This book examines the texts and images of nine English birth girdles produced between the reigns of Richard II and Henry VIII. Cultural artifacts of lay devotion within the birthing chamber, the birth girdles offered the solace and promise of faith to the parturient woman and her attendants amid religious dissent, political upheaval, recurring epidemics, and the onset of print.

Evidence in the Study of Manuscripts and Early Printed Books Joseph A. Dane, 2016-12-05 In this book, Joseph A. Dane critiques

the use of material evidence in studies of manuscript and printed books by delving into accepted notions about the study of print culture He questions the institutional and ideological presuppositions that govern medieval studies descriptive bibliography and library science Dane begins by asking what is the relation between material evidence and the abstract statements made about the evidence ultimately he asks how evidence is to be defined The goal of this book is to show that evidence from texts and written objects often becomes twisted to support pre existing arguments and that generations of bibliographers have created narratives of authorship printing reading and editing that reflect romantic notions of identity growth and development The first part of the book is dedicated to medieval texts and authorship materials include Everyman Chaucer s Legend of Good Women the Anglo Norman Le Seint Resurrection and Adam de la Helle s Le Jeu de Robin et Marion The second half of the book is concerned with abstract notions about books and scholarly definitions about what a book actually is chapters include studies of basic bibliographical concepts Ideal Copy and the application of such a notion in early editions of Chaucer the combination of manuscript and printing in the books of Colard Mansion and finally examples of the organization of books by an early nineteenth century book collector Leander Van Ess This study is an important contribution to debates about the nature of bibliography and the critical institutions that have shaped its current practice

John Gower in England and Iberia Ana Sáez-Hidalgo, R. F.
