Libri al rogo Pierluigi Battista, 2019-11-07T00:00:00+01:00 I libri hanno sempre fatto paura perché le loro pagine possono diffondere il seme della conoscenza della scoperta di una pericolosa libertà. Lo stesso accaduto con quadri, canzoni, film e spettacoli teatrali capaci di conquistare l'emozione del pubblico con la stessa intensità con cui hanno attirato l'avversione di chi ne contestava i principi. Dittatori e benpensanti si sono accaniti contro le opere accusate di turbare l'ordine costituito impedendone la diffusione e perseguitando gli autori. Negli ultimi decenni ai roghi in piazza si è sostituita una pratica solo apparentemente meno feroce: una censura sottile eppure implacabile ispirata ai più nobili motivi ma che rischia di sconfinare nel fanatismo più intollerante. Nel suo nome si mettono all'indice registi e scrittori, si coprono dipinti e si alterano i classici che offendono la sensibilità contemporanea. Pierluigi Battista in un atto d'amore per i libri e il pensiero libero risponde con un infuocato manifesto a favore della libertà d'espressione in difesa di una tolleranza che non ammette deroghe.

Storia universale della distruzione dei libri Fernando Báez, 2010-12-30T00:00:00+01:00 Dove si bruciano i libri si finisce per bruciare anche gli uomini: queste parole di Heinrich Heine ci ricordano che in tutte le epoche e civiltà il libro come strumento di trasmissione delle idee e della memoria è stato vittima del fanatismo e della censura. Da quando è nata la scrittura gli elementi della natura e la volontà distruttrice dell'uomo hanno messo in pericolo la sopravvivenza dei suoi supporti materiali. In questa edizione rivista e ampliata Fernando Báez ricostruisce l'inquietante storia della distruzione dei libri: vittime delle catastrofi naturali, delle fiamme delle guerre e soprattutto dell'intolleranza politica e religiosa. L'itinerario parte dalle tavolette sumere e giunge fino al saccheggio di Bagdad all'inizio del secolo XXI, passando per la sparizione della leggendaria biblioteca di Alessandria, i grandi classici greci perduti ai roghi dell'imperatore cinese Shi Huangdi, la rovina dei papiri di Ercolano, gli abusi degli inquisitori, l'incendio dell'Escorial, l'eliminazione dei libri durante la guerra civile spagnola, le persecuzioni degli scrittori da parte dei totalitarismi del Novecento. *Nessuno poteva aprire il libro...* Mauro Guerrini, 2019-10-31 L'iniziativa di offrire una Festschrift a fr. Silvano M. Danieli per il suo settantesimo compleanno rende omaggio a un uomo, a un professionista che con la sua attività ha lasciato un segno profondo nelle relazioni umane e nel mondo delle biblioteche. Fr. Silvano, bibliotecario della Pontificia Facoltà teologica Marianum e dal 2014 priore della comunità di Studio Marianum di Roma, ha infatti svolto un ruolo strategico nello sviluppo di URBE, l'associazione che riunisce le biblioteche dei pontifici atenei romani in un'unica rete di servizi. Il qualificato elenco dei partecipanti italiani ed europei testimonia l'ampiezza dei gradimenti ottenuti nei suoi trent'anni di attività bibliotecaria e di curatore della Bibliografia dell'Ordine dei Servi e della Bibliografia mariana. Le parole di Aelredo di Rievaulx (1109-1167) la figura di maggior spicco del monachesimo cistercense anglosassone esprimono il senso del dono: Un uomo in virtù dell'amicizia che ha verso un altro uomo diventa amico di Dio secondo quanto dice il Signore nel Vangelo: Non vi chiamo più servi ma amici miei.
