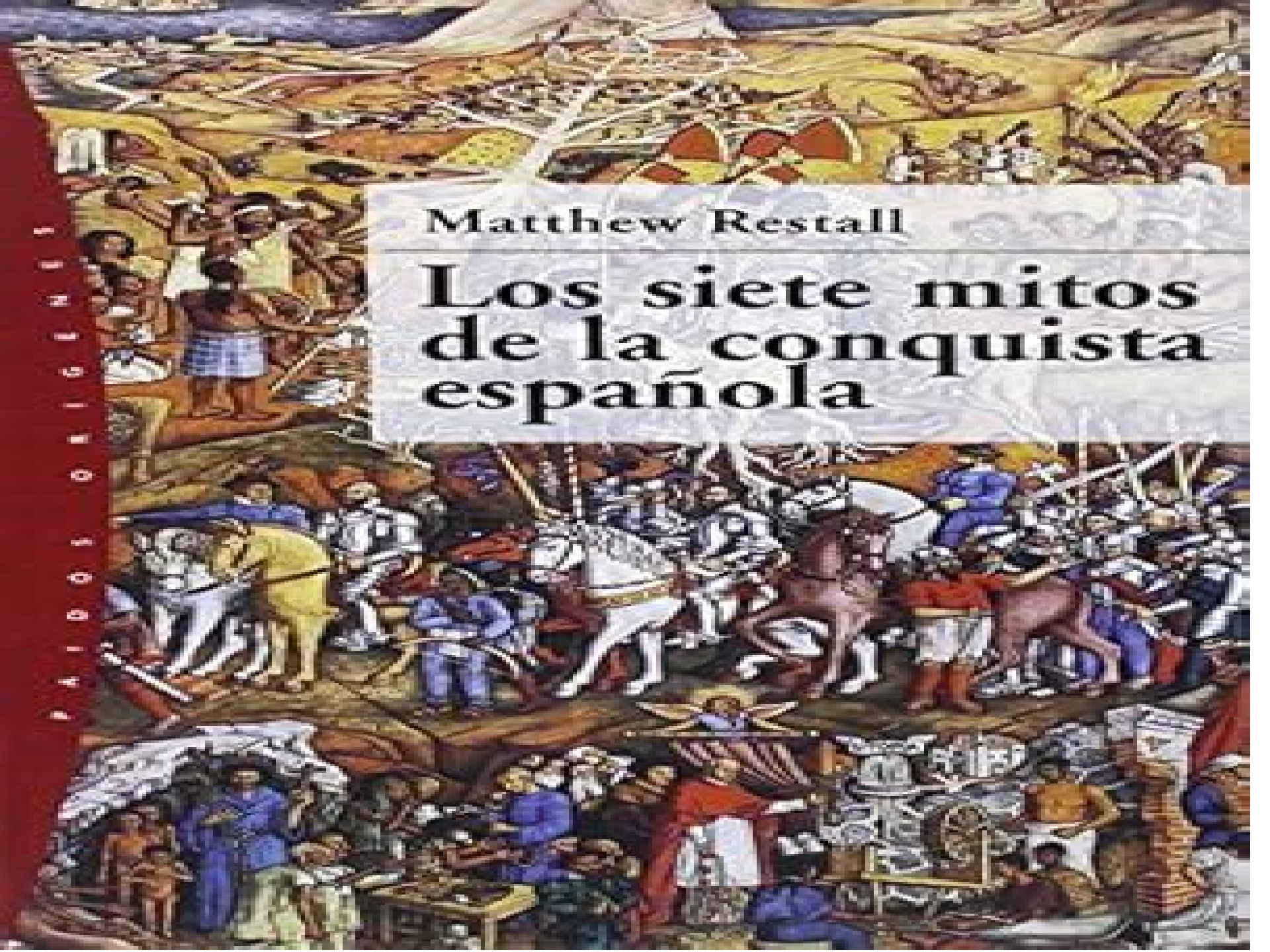

Monarquía Hispánica se benefició de la circulación de sus oficiales y soldados entre Europa, América o Asia al tener a su disposición los complejos conocimientos locales que le hacían llegar desde sus posesiones de ultramar. Esta pluralidad de voces también se hallaba del lado de los indios que con la movilidad que produjo la guerra y el mestizaje que convirtió las ciudades del Nuevo Mundo en un crisol de identidades encontraron la resonancia que les permitió desplegar sus formas de resistencia.

Los siete mitos de la conquista española Matthew Restall, 2004. En este libro se exploran cómo surgieron y pasaron al acervo popular los errores de interpretación acerca de la historia de la conquista española de América. Se ofrece asimismo una nueva crónica de las actividades de los conquistadores y exploradores más célebres entre los que se cuentan Colón, Cortés y Pizarro. A partir de una amplia selección de fuentes, el historiador Matthew Restall destaca siete mitos esenciales en los cuales revela el origen de las inexactitudes y refuta las falacias implícitas. Este texto atractivo y bien documentado muestra por ejemplo que los indígenas americanos no confundían a los conquistadores con dioses y que no es cierta la idea de que unos pocos españoles conquistaron grandes imperios con extraordinaria rapidez enfrentándose a un enemigo numéricamente muy superior. Descubrimos asimismo que Colón era considerado en su tiempo y durante varias décadas después como un navegante en absoluto extraordinario que participó en las campañas donde intervinieron también muchos otros europeos meridionales, una idea que coincide con los hechos históricos. Fue mucho después cuando se caracterizó a Colón como un gran hombre que se enfrentó a la ignorancia de sus contemporáneos para descubrir el nuevo mundo. Restall muestra también que la conquista española dependía en gran medida de los aliados negros e indígenas que proporcionaban muchos miles de combatientes, cifras que superaban con mucho el contingente de conquistadores españoles. Este libro nos enseña que la conquista fue mucho más compleja y más fascinante de lo que la describen las historias convencionales.

La invención de la Malinche Sandra Messinger Cypess, 2023-11-24. Doña Marina, nombrada Malintzin por los indígenas, constituye uno de los personajes más importantes de la Conquista de México. Popularmente conocida como la Malinche, fue hija de un cacique esclava, traductora y guía intérprete de diversas lenguas, una suerte de embajadora cultural y madre de uno de los hijos de Cortés. Este libro, *La invención de la Malinche*, de la historia al mito, es la versión revisada y ampliada del texto originalmente publicado en 1991 en inglés por Sandra Messinger Cypess. Se analizan en él las diversas transformaciones de la representación de Marina en textos literarios y en la cultura popular desde la Colonia hasta el siglo XXI. Basado en escritos de Hernán Cortés, Bernal Díaz del Castillo, Irene Paz, Miguel León Portilla, Octavio Paz, Elena Garro, Rosario Castellanos, Sabina Berman, Margo Glantz y Jesús Rodríguez, entre otros escritores y artistas, se sostiene en él la tesis de que la comprensión de esta figura depende de la ideología de quienes la interpretan. La Malinche, como se apunta en la introducción, continúa siendo un paradigma objeto de estudio con base en diversas fuentes e ideologías. Así de manera cada vez más unívoca hoy se le ve como una mujer enigmática, polifacética.
