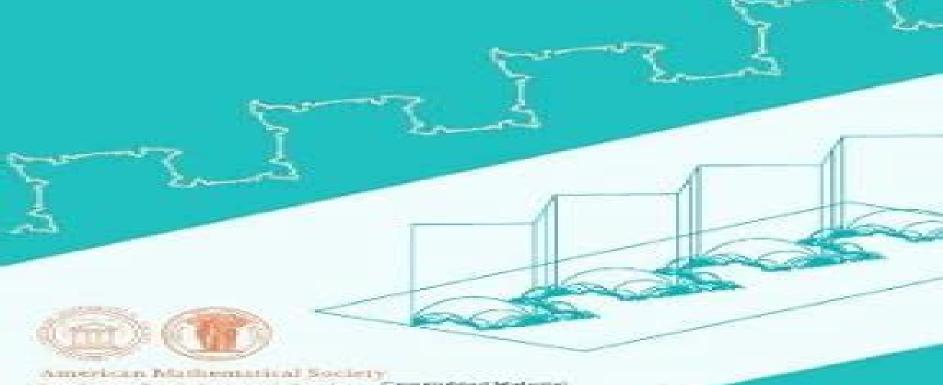

used to describe a knot This textbook provides background on these problems and tools to determine hyperbolic information on knots It also includes results and state of the art techniques on hyperbolic geometry and knot theory to date The book was written to be interactive with many examples and exercises Some important results are left to guided exercises The level is appropriate for graduate students with a basic background in algebraic topology particularly fundamental groups and covering spaces Some experience with some differential topology and Riemannian geometry will also be helpful
