new technology can spawn a new industry that is unconstrained by tradition, creating jobs and power for ambitious women and minorities. A classic example is the American motion picture business in the period 1920-1950. Immigrant Jews and their offspring, traditionally excluded from the dominant sectors of finance and manufacturing, rose to positions of power and influence. In her book Invisible Stars: A Social History of Women in Broadcasting, Donna Halper has chronicled the fortunes of women in a field which initially seemed to offer them great opportunity but which failed to deliver on its promise.

Commercial broadcasting began on a sustained basis in the United States in 1920. Many readers know of station KDKA in Pittsburgh which in simple narratives is claimed to represent the start of radio as we know it in America. It is approximately here that Halper begins the story of women in broadcasting, with a nod to those employed as wireless telegraphy operators in the war just ended. She ends her story at the conclusion of the twentieth century, inevitably taking us through the history of women in television. Halper has worked in the radio industry for over 25 years and her book shows some special attention toward radio - as opposed to television. Her method is mainly anecdotal, and relies heavily on the experiences of some 15-20 women, a few who are still living. Some names will perhaps be familiar: e.g., Frieda Hennock, the first woman appointed to the FCC (1948) and Pauline Frederick who had an important career in broadcasting news for radio, and later, television. It is part of Halper's engaging manner that she berself turns up as a character in her story, and we learn that in 1968 she became the first woman announcer on the Northeastern University radio station; a picture of her at the station's controls appears in the photography section.

Halper leads into the 1920s with one of her most interesting characters, Eunice Randall, who in 1918 worked for the AMRAD Corporation of Medford, MA, as a technical illustrator. AMRAD had supplied wireless equipment to the military during the Great War. Moving through the ranks of the companie, which had operated an experimental station pre-1920, she was in a few years not only announcing on their station. WBL but also engineering, climbing the broadcast tower to make repairs, and reading children's stories over the air in the evening. The Boston papers took note of her work and she remains a significant figure for radio biscorians.

The early 1920s, the era of "the radio craze," is a period in some ways reminiscent of the recently passed computer and dot-com madness. New stations blossomed up all the time - by the end of 1922 there were 576 on the air while annual sales of radios grew from 560 million in 1922 to \$358 million in 1924. There was work for the talented and ambitious, and women readily found employment not only as announcers but as program directors and live entertainers. Because much of early broadcasting involved live music and because women often operated music schools, and were more apt to have received music education than men, they were a natural fit in the emerging industry. This boom period for women was short-lived, drawing to an end in the 1920s even before the stock market crash. This shrinking of opportunities for women has no simple explanation, but was implemented in part by a spreading conception that women's voices were unsuited to the medium of radio - listeners allegedly wanted to hear male voices. An article in Scientific American of 1928 by an electrical engineer purports to show that the voice of a soprano singer was unpleasantly distorted by the available microphones and receivers of the day. Such arguments provided dubious support to those arguing that women's voices were unsuited to the nonsinging role of announcer, but the argument was made. in the radio columns of the mainstream press, including the New York Times, as early as 1926.
