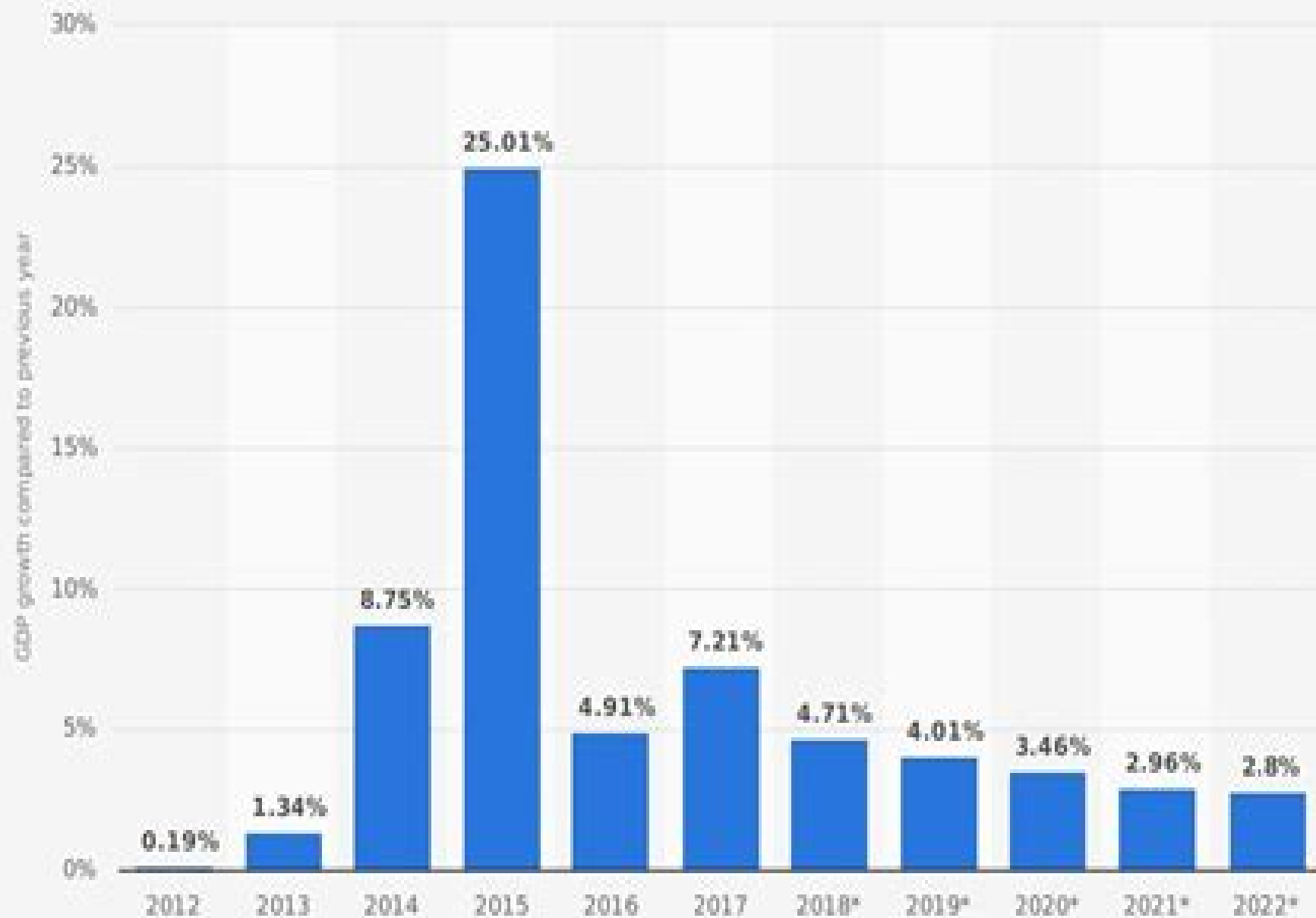


Ireland: Growth rate of the real gross domestic product (GDP) from 2012 to 2022 (compared to the previous year)

New Economic History It sets out to test hypotheses about the causal connections between economic and non economic phenomena Irish history is often heavily coloured by political convictions of Dutch Jewish origin trained in Israel and working in the United States Mokyr brings to this controversial field not only wide research experience but also impartiality and scientific objectivity The book is primarily aimed at numerate economic historians historical demographers economists specializing in agricultural economics and economic development and specialists in Irish and British nineteenth century history The text is nonetheless free of technical jargon with the more complex material relegated to appendixes Mokyr s line of reasoning is transparent and has been easily accessible and useful to readers without graduate training in economic theory and econometrics since its first publication in 1983
