Groupthink Irving Lester Janis, 1982 Groupthink the psychological drive for consensus at any cost that suppresses disagreement and prevents the appraisal of alternatives in cohesive decision making groups In the first edition Victims of groupthink Irving L Janis showed how this phenomenon contributed to some of the major U S foreign policy fiascos of recent decades the Korean War stalemate the escalation of the Vietnam War the failure to be prepared for the attack on Pearl Harbor and the Bay of Pigs blunder He also examined cases such as the handling of the Cuban Missile Crisis and the formulation of the Marshall Plan where groupthink was avoided Here in this revised and expanded edition Janis applies his hypothesis to the Watergate cover up portraying in detail how groupthink helped to put the participants on a disastrous course and keep them there In addition he presents some fresh ideas on how and why groupthink occurs and offers suggestions for avoiding it
