beginnings in the 1850s to its later expansion on the outskirts of London to Petrolia and finally to Sarnia He accounts for all of the industry's important developments and innovations particularly the role played by municipalities in fostering its growth Using extensive archival research Cobban concludes that municipalities can stimulate the accelerated sustained development of local industry sectors thus challenging the dominant view that the influence of municipalities on economic growth is marginal Cities of Oil demonstrates the importance of accommodating the land and infrastructure needs of industry at critical junctures and implementing land use policies that encourage the dense clustering of industries This book will be essential reading for those seeking a greater understanding of industrial growth in the province of Ontario *James Van Allen* Abigail Foerstner, 2009-06 Astrophysicist and space pioneer James Van Allen 1914 2006 for whom the Van Allen radiation belts were named was among the principal scientific investigators for twenty four space missions including Explorer I in 1958 the first successful U S satellite Mariner 2's 1962 flyby of Venus the first successful mission to another planet and the 1970s Pioneer 10 and Pioneer 11 missions that surveyed Jupiter and Saturn Although he retired as a University of Iowa professor of physics and astronomy in 1985 he remained an active researcher using his campus office to monitor data from Pioneer 10 on course to reach the edge of the solar system when its signal was lost in 2003 until a short time before his death at the age of ninety one Now Abigail Foerstner blends space science drama military agendas cold war politics and the events of Van Allen's lengthy career to create the first biography of this highly influential physicist Drawing on Van Allen's correspondence and publications years of interviews with him as well as with more than a hundred other people and declassified documents from such archives as the Jet Propulsion Laboratory the Kennedy Space Center and the Applied Physics Laboratory Foerstner describes Van Allen's life from his Iowa childhood to his first experiments at White Sands to the years of Explorer I until his death in 2006 Often called the father of space science James Van Allen led the way to mapping a new solar system based on the solar wind massive solar storms and cosmic rays Pioneer 10 alone sent him more than thirty years of readings that helped push our recognition of the boundary of the solar system billions of miles past Pluto Abigail Foerstner's compelling biography charts the eventful life and time of this trailblazing physicist **Prior Art** Peter H. Christensen, 2024-05-07 A groundbreaking text on the history of the use of patents in architecture Although patents existed in Renaissance Italy and even in Confucian thought it was not until the middle third of the nineteenth century that architects embraced the practice of patenting in significant numbers Patents could ensure as they did for architects engineering brethren the economic and cultural benefits afforded by exclusive intellectual property rights But patent culture was never directly translatable to the field of architecture which tended to negotiate issues of technological innovation in the context of the more abstract issues of artistic influence and formal expression In *Prior Art* scholar Peter Christensen offers the first full scale monographic treatment of this complex relationship between art and invention Christensen's method a site oriented approach steeped in multinational and multilingual archival work is geared toward unifying fractured global histories of

The Defoliation of America Amy Marie Hay, 2021-12-14 In *The Defoliation of America* Amy M Hay profiles the attitudes understandings and motivations of grassroots activists who rose to fight the use of phenoxy herbicides commonly known as the Agent Orange chemicals in various aspects of American life during the post WWII era First introduced in 1946 these chemicals mimic hormones in broadleaf plants causing them to essentially grow to death while grass grains and other monocots remain unaffected By the 1950s millions of pounds of chemicals were produced annually for use in brush control weed eradication other agricultural applications and forest management The herbicides allowed suburban lawns to take root and become iconic symbols of success in American life The production and application of phenoxy defoliants continued to skyrocket in subsequent years encouraged by market forces and unimpeded by regulatory oversight By the late 1950s however pockets of skepticism and resistance had begun to appear The trend picked up steam after 1962 when Rachel Carson's *Silent Spring* directed mainstream attention to the harm modern chemicals were causing in the natural world But it wasn't until the Vietnam War when nearly 40 million gallons of Agent Orange and related herbicides were sprayed to clear the canopy and destroy crops in Southeast Asia that the long term damage associated with this group of chemicals began to attract widespread attention and alarm Using a wide array of sources and an interdisciplinary approach *The Defoliation of America* is organized in three parts Part 1 1945-70 examines the development use and responses to the new chemicals used to control weeds and remove jungle growth As the herbicides became militarized critics increasingly expressed concerns about defoliation in protests over US imperialism in Southeast Asia Part 2 1965-85 profiles three different women who influenced by Rachel Carson challenged the uses of the herbicides in the American West affecting US chemical policy and regulations in the process Part 3 1970-95 revisits the impact and legacies of defoliant use after the Vietnam War From countercultural containment and Nixon's declaration of the War on Drugs to the toxic effects on American and Vietnamese veterans civilians and their children it became increasingly obvious that American herbicides damaged far more than forest canopies With sensitivity to the role gender played in these various protests Hay's study of the scientists health and environmental activists and veterans who fought US chemical regulatory policies and practices reveals the mechanisms obligations and constraints of state and scientific authority in midcentury America Hay also shows how these disparate and mostly forgotten citizen groups challenged the political consensus and were able to shift government and industry narratives of chemical safety

Brandt, 2003-05-31 Carl A Gerstacker was born in 1916 in Cleveland Ohio At an early age his father Rollin instilled in him an interest in finance and the stock market In 1930 when Carl turned fourteen Rollin advised his son to withdraw his paper route and odd job money from a local bank and invest it all in The Dow Chemical Company It was the beginning of a relationship that would last a lifetime After high school Carl landed an hourly position with Dow Chemical as a lab assistant and at the same time pursued an engineering degree at the University of Michigan as part of the company s student training course After graduating in 1938 Gerstacker continued to work for Dow Chemical until the outbreak of World War II when he joined the U S Army Returning to civilian life in 1946 he was rehired by Dow and quickly moved up the corporate ladder becoming Treasurer in 1949 Vice President in 1955 and Chairman of the Board in 1960 a position he retained until 1976 He retired five years later in 1981 Carl Gerstacker was a business leader who believed that every company had a special personality and that the Dow personality was largely shaped by its employees For Dow Chemical people are the most important asset not the patents the plants nor the products Gerstacker s personal financial acumen was rivaled only by his own contributions to the sound corporate growth of Dow Chemical a business he loved and to which he devoted his life Gerstacker died in 1995 leaving a legacy that lives on in the form of numerous philanthropic endeavors he began during his

lifetime and on whose boards he once served Carl A Gerstacker was one of the towering figures of twentieth century American industry **Faith, Resistance, and the Future** James L. Marsh, Anna J. Sujay Rao Mandavilli, 2024-11-22 The term Homo sapiens is the scientific nomenclature for the anatomically modern man This term literally means thinking man Modern humans are found all over the world in different regions and are probably the most successful species in modern times just like the dinosaurs were some one hundred million years ago Homo Sapiens are the most common and widespread species of primate or great apes and the last surviving species of the genus Homo all others have either become extinct or have lost their distinct identity The term Humans is also most often used only to Homo Sapiens and not to all other species in the genus homo which are sometimes referred to as archaic humans Humans also possess a high level of intelligence and a great deal of cognitive ability and cognitive skills due to a large prefrontal cortex and this feature attribute and characteristic besides other features such as bipedalism and opposing thumbs have distinguished and differentiated it from other species

These aspects have also allowed humans to dominate the earth and build impressive civilizations that have immense technological clout Humans are also a polytypic species there are wide variations among humans inhabiting different parts of the globe even though the traditional and orthodox classification of humans into races may be highly obsolete and may even be associated with unwanted and unintended consequences both direct and indirect However variations between humans is much less than in other species such as dogs and any two humans are at least 99.5% genetically similar Humans are also highly social creatures and tend to form either small or large social and cultural units that are known for their social and cultural bonding These may be either large or small and in the words of CH Cooley be primary or secondary groups that promote we feeling and out feeling and help humans bond Cooley 1909

The American Synthetic Organic Chemicals Industry Kathryn Steen, 2014-08-03 Prior to 1914 Germany dominated the worldwide production of synthetic organic dyes and pharmaceuticals like aspirin When World War I disrupted the supply of German chemicals to the United States American entrepreneurs responded to the shortages and high prices by trying to manufacture chemicals domestically Learning the complex science and industry however posed a serious challenge This book explains how the United States built a synthetic organic chemicals industry in World War I and the 1920s Kathryn Steen argues that Americans intense anti German sentiment in World War I helped to forge a concentrated effort among firms the federal government and universities to make the United States independent of foreign chemicals Besides mobilization efforts to make high explosives and war gases federal policies included protective tariffs gathering and publishing market information and most dramatically confiscation of German owned chemical subsidiaries and patents Meanwhile firms and universities worked hard to develop scientific and manufacturing expertise Against a backdrop of hostilities and intrigue Steen shows how chemicals were deeply entwined with national and international politics and policy during the war and subsequent isolationism of the turbulent early twentieth century
