responsible parenthood In this light I raise the question as to how biomedical engineers can take and shape professional responsibility for this kind of normative work with respect to bodies To study normative work in biomedical engineering I have analysed the practice of tissue engineering TE In this practice engineers rather literally make human body parts TE has as objective to create living body part substitutes e g skin heart valves and bladders by using cells In the tradition of Science and Technology Studies STS I have studied normative work in TE empirically by following a specific TE project namely a TE heart valve project through participant observations interviews and other fieldwork approaches To be able to analyse how the practice of TE affects lived bodies I draw on work in the philosophical tradition of phenomenology This tradition has as central concept the lived body rather than the body as object In this book I show how TE implies normative work for engineers in the presentation of their work in terms of mimicking nature in making standards for TE heart valves and in developing networks to stimulate the further development of TE and to enable the impleme
