Mythologies of Internal Exile in Elizabethan Verse A.D. Cousins, 2018-10-26. Writers of the English Renaissance like their European contemporaries frequently reflect on the phenomenon of exile, an experience that forces the individual to establish a new personal identity in an alien environment. Although there has been much commentary on this phenomenon as represented in English Renaissance literature, there has been nothing written at length about its counterpart, namely, internal exile, marginalization, or estrangement within the homeland. This volume considers internal exile as a simultaneously twofold experience. It studies estrangement from one's society and correlatively from one's normative sense of self.
