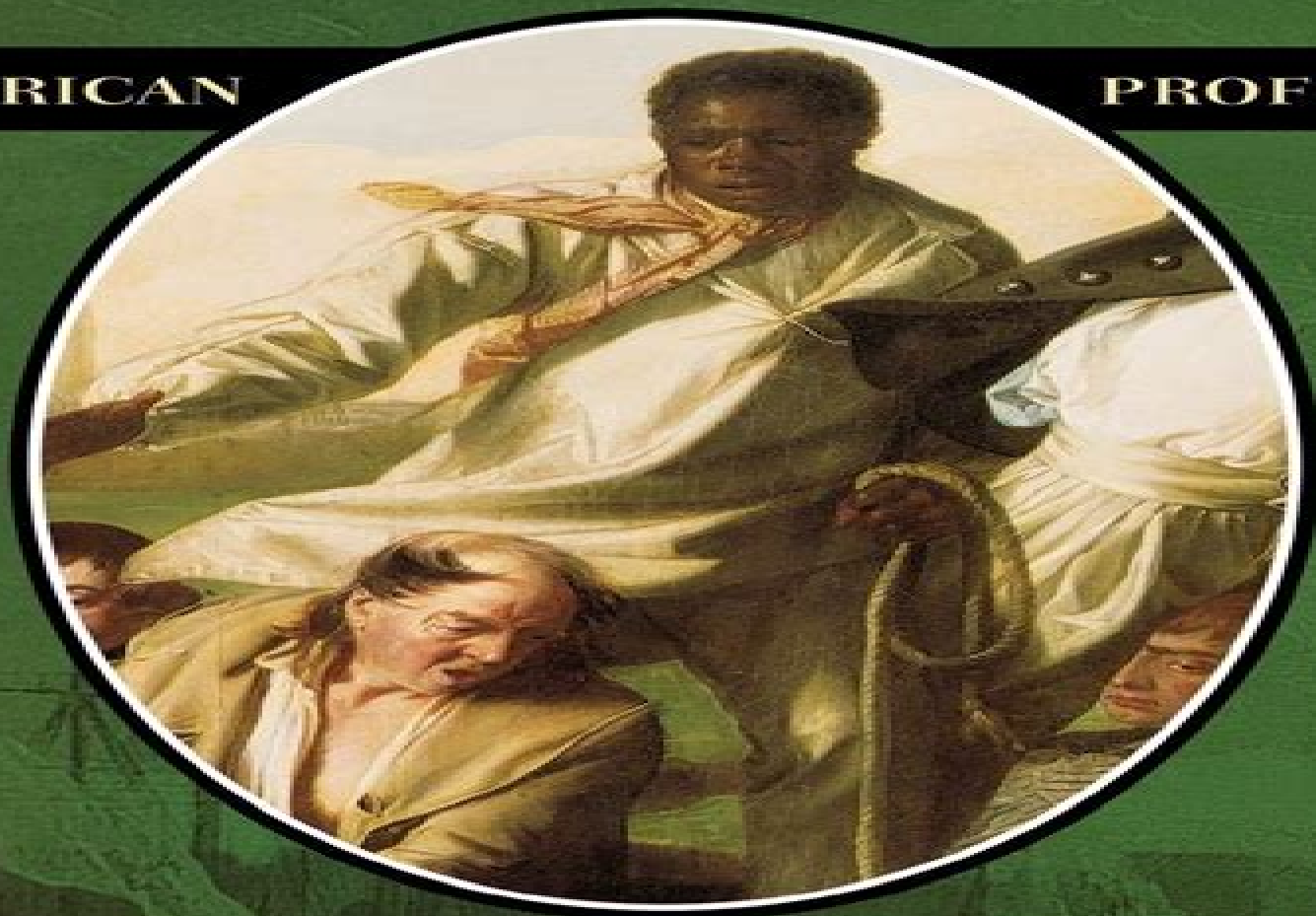

He Shall Go Out Free Douglas R. Egerton, 2004-12-10 On July 2 1822 Denmark Vesey was hanged in Charleston S C for his role in planning one of the largest slave uprisings in the United States During his long extraordinary life Vesey played many roles Caribbean field hand cabin boy Chandler's man house servant proud freeman carpenter husband father church leader abolitionist revolutionary Yet until his execution transformed him into a symbol of liberty Vesey made it his life's work to avoid the attention of white authorities Because he preferred to dwell in the hidden alleys of Charleston's slave community Vesey remains as elusive as he is today celebrated and his legend is often mistaken for fact In this biography of the great rebel leader Douglas R Egerton employs a variety of historical sources church records court documents travel accounts and newspapers from America and Saint Domingue to recreate the lost world of the mysterious Vesey The revised and updated edition reflects the most recent scholarship on Vesey and a new afterword by the author explores the current debate about the existence of the 1822 conspiracy If Vesey's plot was unique in the annals of slave rebellions in North America it was because he was unique his goals as well as the methods he chose to achieve them were the product of a hard life's experience

The American Crucible Robin Blackburn, 2013-08-06 The American Crucible furnishes a vivid and authoritative history of the rise and fall of slavery in the Americas For over three centuries enslavement promoted the rise of capitalism in the Atlantic world The New World became the crucible for a succession of fateful experiments in colonization silver mining plantation agriculture racial enslavement colonial rebellion slave witness and slave resistance Slave produce raised up empires fostered new cultures of consumption and financed the breakthrough to an industrial order Not until the stirrings of a revolutionary age in the 1780s was there the first public challenge to the peculiar institution An anti slavery alliance then set the scene for great acts of emancipation in Haiti in 1804 Britain in 1833 8 the United States in the 1860s and Cuba and Brazil in the 1880s In The American Crucible Robin Blackburn argues that the anti slavery movement forged many of the ideals we live by today The best treatment of slavery in the western hemisphere I know of I think it should establish itself as a permanent pillar of the literature Eric Hobsbawm

Death or Liberty Douglas R. Egerton, 2009-01-13 In Death or Liberty Douglas R Egerton offers a sweeping chronicle of African American history stretching from Britain's 1763 victory in the Seven Years War to the election of slaveholder Thomas Jefferson as president in 1800 While American slavery is usually identified with antebellum cotton plantations Egerton shows that on the eve of the Revolution it encompassed everything from wading in the South Carolina rice fields to carting goods around Manhattan to serving the households of Boston's elite More important he recaptures the drama of slaves freed blacks and white reformers fighting to make the young nation fulfill its republican

slogans Although this struggle often unfolded in the corridors of power Egerton pays special attention to what black Americans did for themselves in these decades and his narrative brims with compelling portraits of forgotten African American activists and rebels who battled huge odds and succeeded in finding liberty if never equality only in northern states Egerton concludes that despite the real possibility of peaceful if gradual emancipation the Founders ultimately lacked the courage to end slavery

The Original Meaning of the Fourteenth Amendment Randy E. Barnett, Evan D. Bernick, 2021-11-02

A renowned constitutional scholar and a rising star provide a balanced and definitive analysis of the origins and original meaning of the Fourteenth Amendment Adopted in 1868 the Fourteenth Amendment profoundly changed the Constitution giving the federal judiciary and Congress new powers to protect the fundamental rights of individuals from being violated by the states Yet according to Randy Barnett and Evan Bernick the Supreme Court has long misunderstood or ignored the original meaning of the amendment's key clauses covering the privileges and immunities of citizenship due process of law and the equal protection of the laws Barnett and Bernick contend that the Fourteenth Amendment was the culmination of decades of debates about the meaning of the antebellum Constitution Antislavery advocates advanced arguments informed by natural rights the Declaration of Independence and the common law They also utilized what is today called public meaning originalism Although their arguments lost in the courts the Republican Party was formed to advance an antislavery political agenda eventually bringing about abolition Then when abolition alone proved insufficient to thwart Southern repression and provide for civil equality the Fourteenth Amendment was enacted It went beyond abolition to enshrine in the Constitution the concept of Republican citizenship and granted Congress power to protect fundamental rights and ensure equality before the law Finally Congress used its powers to pass Reconstruction era civil rights laws that tell us much about the original scope of the amendment With evenhanded attention to primary sources *The Original Meaning of the Fourteenth Amendment* shows how the principles of the Declaration eventually came to modify the Constitution and proposes workable doctrines for implementing the key provisions of Section 1 of the Fourteenth Amendment

Buried Lives Michele Lise Tarter, Richard Bell, 2012 *Buried Lives* offers the first critical examination of the experience of imprisonment in early America These interdisciplinary essays investigate several carceral institutions to show how confinement shaped identity politics and the social imaginary both in the colonies and in the new nation The historians and literary scholars included in this volume offer a complement and corrective to conventional understandings of incarceration that privilege the intentions of those in power over the experiences of prisoners Considering such varied settings as jails penitentiaries almshouses workhouses floating prison ships and plantations the contributors reconstruct the struggles of people imprisoned in locations from Antigua to Boston The essays draw upon a rich array of archival sources from the seventeenth century to the eve of the Civil War including warden logs petitions execution sermons physicians clinical notes private letters newspaper articles runaway slave advertisements and legal documents Through the voices bodies and texts of the incarcerated *Buried Lives*

reveals the largely ignored experiences of inmates who contested their subjection to regimes of power *The Slow Undoing* Stephen H. Lowe, 2021-06-02 A study of how South Carolina's federal district courts were central to achieving and solidifying gains during the civil rights movement As the first comprehensive study of one state's federal district courts during the long civil rights movement *The Slow Undoing* argues for a reconsideration of the role of the federal courts in the civil rights movement It places the courts as a central battleground at the intersections of struggles over race law and civil rights During the long civil rights movement Black and White South Carolinians used the courts as a venue to contest the meanings of the constitution justice equality and citizenship African American plaintiffs and lawyers from South Carolina with the support of Thurgood Marshall and other lawyers from the NAACP Legal Defense and Education Fund brought and argued civil rights lawsuits in South Carolina's federal courts attempting to secure the vote raise teacher salaries and to equalize and then desegregate schools parks and public life In response white citizens state politicians and local officials hired their own lawyers who countered these arguments by crafting new legal theories in an attempt to defend state practices and thwart African American aspirations of equality and to preserve white supremacy *The Slow Undoing* argues for a reconsideration of the role of federal courts in the civil rights movement by demonstrating that both before and after *Brown v Board of Education* the federal district courts were centrally important to achieving and solidifying civil rights gains It relies on the entire legal record of actions in the federal district courts of South Carolina from 1940 to 1970 to make the case It argues that rather than relying on litigation during the pre *Brown* era and direct action in the post *Brown* era African Americans instead used courts and direct action in tandem to bring down legal segregation throughout the long civil rights era But the process was far from linear and the courts were not always a progressive force The battles were long the victories won were often imperfect and many of the fights remain Author Stephen H Lowe offers a chronicle of this enduring struggle Wolf by the Ears John R. Van Atta, 2015-05-15 The first organized Louisiana Purchase territory to lie completely west of the Mississippi River and northwest of the Ohio Missouri carried special significance for both pro and anti slavery advocates Northern congressmen leaped out of their seats to object to the proposed expansion of the slave empire while slave state politicians voiced outrage at the Northerners' blatant sectional attack Although the Missouri confrontation ultimately appeared to end amicably with a famous compromise that the wily Kentuckian Henry Clay helped to cobble together the passions it unleashed proved vicious widespread and long lasting Van Atta deftly explains how the Missouri crisis revealed the power that slavery had already gained over American nation building He explores the external social cultural and economic forces that gave the confrontation such urgency around the country as well as the beliefs assumptions and fears that characterized both sides of the slavery argument **Toussaint Louverture and the American Civil War** Matthew J. Clavin, 2012-02-23 At the end of the eighteenth century a massive slave revolt rocked French Saint Domingue the most profitable European colony in the Americas Under the leadership of the charismatic former slave François Dominique

Toussaint Louverture a disciplined and determined republican army consisting almost entirely of rebel slaves defeated all of its rivals and restored peace to the embattled territory. The slave uprising that we now refer to as the Haitian Revolution concluded on January 1, 1804, with the establishment of Haiti, the first black republic in the Western Hemisphere. The Haitian Revolution cast a long shadow over the Atlantic world. In the United States, according to Matthew J. Clavin, there emerged two competing narratives that vied for the revolution's legacy. One emphasized vengeful African slaves committing unspeakable acts of violence against white men, women, and children. The other was the story of an enslaved people who, under the leadership of Louverture, vanquished their oppressors in an effort to eradicate slavery and build a new nation. Toussaint Louverture and the American Civil War examines the significance of these competing narratives in American society on the eve of and during the Civil War. Clavin argues that at the height of the longstanding conflict between North and South, Louverture and the Haitian Revolution were resonant polarizing symbols which antislavery and proslavery groups exploited both to provoke a violent confrontation and to determine the fate of slavery in the United States. In public orations and printed texts, African Americans and their white allies insisted that the Civil War was a second Haitian Revolution, a bloody conflict in which thousands of armed bondmen, American Toussaints, would redeem the republic by securing the abolition of slavery and proving the equality of the black race. Southern secessionists and northern anti-abolitionists responded by launching a cultural counterrevolution to prevent a second Haitian Revolution from taking place.

James Hamilton of South Carolina Robert Tinkler, 2004-09-01. An esteemed planter, politician, and military leader influential in the affairs of both South Carolina and Texas, James Hamilton (1786-1857) so declined in reputation during the last twenty years of his life that his home state refused to acknowledge him when he died. Robert Tinkler's superb first published biography of Hamilton conveys the enormous drama, dignity, and pathos that marked Hamilton's pursuit of the greatness achieved by his prominent Revolutionary era forebears and his subsequent profound reversal brought on by debt. While a member of Congress during the 1820s, Hamilton came to champion states' interests over a strong central national government. As governor of South Carolina (1830-1832), he reached the pinnacle of his political and social glory when he presided over the Nullification Crisis. In 1832, Hamilton's undoing began with a series of ill-advised cotton speculations that left him deeply and very publicly in arrears. By 1839, he desperately sought relief, even supporting the Compromise of 1850 in hopes of monetary benefit while alienating his old allies in the process. To his fellow southerners, Hamilton became a scourge and embarrassment as one who compromised his political beliefs because of fiscal distress. Perhaps even more than his political apostasy, Hamilton's unforgivable offense may have been to remind planters of their own struggles with chronic debt. Tinkler's extraordinary research into both Hamilton's life and the dynamics of reputation and debt in the antebellum South suggests that many contemporaries simply wished to forget Hamilton's plight so as to avoid facing their own financial reality. Possessing the weight of tragedy, James Hamilton of South Carolina documents a powerful man's achievements and the events and personal

flaws that led to his fall **A Black Jurist in a Slave Society** Keila Grinberg,2019-10-18 Now in English for the first time Keila Grinberg s compelling study of the nineteenth century jurist Antonio Pereira Rebou as 1798 1880 traces the life of an Afro Brazilian intellectual who rose from a humble background to play a key and conflicted role as Brazilians struggled to define citizenship and understand racial politics One of the most prominent specialists in civil law of his time Rebou as explained why blacks fought stridently for their own inclusion in society but also complicitly embraced an ethic of silence on race more broadly Grinberg argues that while this silence was crucial for defining spaces of social mobility and respectability regardless of race it was also stifling and played an important role in quelling political mobilization based on racial identity Rebou as s commitment to liberal ideals also exemplifies the contradiction he embodied though he rejected movements that were grounded in racial political mobilization he was consistently treated as potentially dangerous for the single fact that he was of African origin Grinberg demonstrates how Rebou as s life and career encompassing such themes as racial politics and identities slavery and racism and imperfect citizenship are central for our understanding of Atlantic slave and post abolition societies **Rise of American Democracy** Sean Wilentz,2006-08-29 A political history of how the fledgling American republic developed into a democratic state offers insight into how historical beliefs about democracy compromised democratic progress and identifies the roles of key contributors **Proslavery and Sectional Thought in the Early South, 1740-1829** Jeffrey Robert Young,2020-09-23 Thirteen treatises recall the history of slavery s defenders beginning in the colonial South In Proslavery and Sectional Thought in the Early South 1740 1829 Jeffrey Robert Young has assembled thirteen texts that reveal the development of proslavery perspectives across the colonial and early national South from Maryland to Georgia The tracts lectures sermons and petitions in this volume demonstrate that defenses of human bondage had a history in southern thought that long predated the later antebellum era traditionally associated with the genesis of such positive defenses of slavery Previous anthologies notably Drew Gilpin Faust s *The Ideology of Slavery* have made the perspectives of antebellum slavery s defenders widely available to scholars and students but earlier proslavery thinkers have remained largely inaccessible to modern readers Young s anthology offers a corrective In his introduction to the volume Young explores the relationship between proslavery thought Christianity racism and sectionalism He emphasizes the ways in which justifications for slavery were introduced into the American South by reformers who hoped to integrate the region into a transatlantic religious community These early proponents of slavery tended to minimize racial distinctions between master and slave and they hoped to minimize the cultural distance between southern plantations and English society Only in the early nineteenth century with the rise of an increasingly influential abolition movement did proslavery thinkers begin to justify their beliefs with approaches that underscored differences between North and South Even then the theorists included in this anthology emphasized the extent to which southern slaveholders claims to mastery were rooted in a Western moral tradition that reached back to antiquity *Teaching American History* Gary J.
