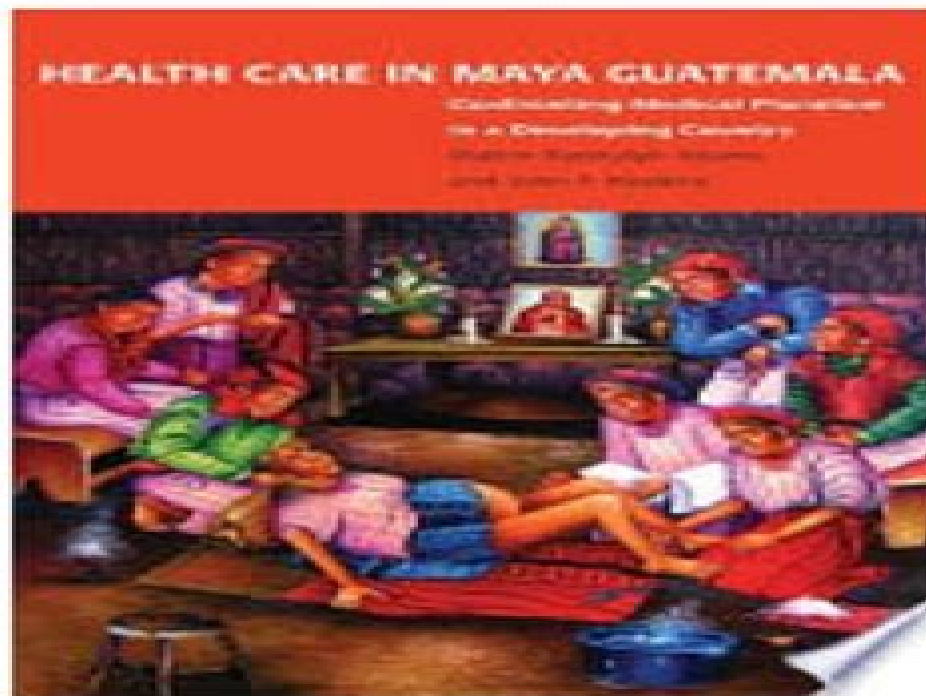

Hawkins, 2021-05-01 Mayas and indeed all Guatemalans are currently experiencing the collapse of their way of life. This collapse is disrupting ideologies, symbols, life practices, and social structures that have undergirded their society for almost five hundred years, and it is causing rapid and massive religious transformation among the K'iche' Maya living in highland western Guatemala. Many Maya are converting to Christian Pentecostal faiths in which adherents and leaders become bodily agitated during worship. Drawing on over fifty years of research and data collected by field school students, Hawkins argues that two factors, cultural collapse and systematic social and economic exclusion, explain the recent religious transformation of Maya Guatemala and the style and emotional intensity through which that transformation is expressed. Guatemala serves as a window on religious change around the world, and Hawkins examines the rapid pentecostalization of Christianity not only within Guatemala but also throughout the global South. The contributors to this volume, who lived among the villagers for some time, include both undergraduate students and distinguished scholars. They describe the ways Mayas struggle to survive and make sense of their lives both within their communities and in relation to the politico-economic institutions of the nation and the world. Since Guatemala's thirty-six year civil war ended in 1996, the state has been dysfunctional, the country's economy

precarious and physical safety uncertain The intrusion of Mexican cartels led the U S State Department to declare Guatemala the epicenter of the drug threat in Central America Rapid cultural change weak state governance organized crime pervasive corruption and ethnic exclusion provide the backdrop for the studies in this volume Seven nuanced ethnographies collected here reveal the complexities of indigenous life and describe physical and cultural conflicts within and between villages between insiders and outsiders and between local and federal governments Many of these essays point to a tragic irony the communities seem largely forgotten by the government until the state seeks to capture their resources timber minerals votes Other chapters portray villages responding to criminal activity through lynch mobs and by labeling nonconformist youth as gang members In focusing on the internal dynamics of poor marginal communities in Guatemala this book explores the realities of life for indigenous people on all continents who are faced with the social changes brought about by war and globalization

copybook Recently discovered in the archives of Brigham Young University the Teabo Manuscript represents a Yucatecan Maya recounting of various aspects of Christian doctrine including the creation of the world the Fall of Adam and Eve and the genealogy of Christ The Teabo Manuscript presents the first English translation and analysis of this late colonial Maya language document a facsimile and transcription of which are also included in the book Working through the manuscript section by section Christensen makes a strong case for its native authorship as well as its connections with other European and Maya religious texts including the Morely Manuscript and the Books of Chilam Balam He uses the Teabo Manuscript as a platform to explore various topics such as the evangelization of the Maya their literary compositions and the aspects of Christianity that they deemed important enough to write about and preserve This pioneering research offers important new insights into how the Maya negotiated their precontact intellectual traditions within a Spanish and Catholic colonial world

Rethinking Mexican Indigenismo Stephen E. Lewis, 2018-05-01 Mexico's National Indigenist Institute INI was at the vanguard of hemispheric indigenismo from 1951 through the mid 1970s thanks to the innovative development projects that were first introduced at its pilot Tseltal Tsotsil Coordinating Center in highland Chiapas This book traces how indigenista innovation gave way to stagnation as local opposition shifting national priorities and waning financial support took their toll After 1970 indigenismo may have served the populist aims of president Luis Echeverría but Mexican anthropologists indigenistas and the indigenous themselves increasingly challenged INI theory and practice and rendered them obsolete

Midwives and Mothers Sheila Cosminsky, 2016-12-06 The World Health Organization is currently promoting a policy of replacing traditional or lay midwives in countries around the world As part of an effort to record the knowledge of local midwives before it is lost Midwives and Mothers explores birth illness death and survival on a Guatemalan sugar and coffee plantation or finca through the lives of two local midwives Doña María and her daughter Doña Sira and the women they have served over a forty year period By comparing the practices and beliefs of the mother and daughter Sheila Cosminsky shows the dynamics of the medicalization process and the contestation between the midwives and biomedical personnel as the latter try to impose their system as the authoritative one She discusses how the midwives syncretize integrate or reject elements from Mayan Spanish and biomedical systems The midwives story becomes a lens for understanding the impact of medicalization on people's lives and the ways in which women's bodies have become contested terrain between traditional and contemporary medical practices Cosminsky also makes recommendations for how ethno obstetric and biomedical systems may be accommodated articulated or integrated Finally she places the changes in the birthing system in the larger context of changes in the plantation system including the elimination of coffee growing which has made women traditionally the primary harvesters of coffee beans more economically dependent on men
