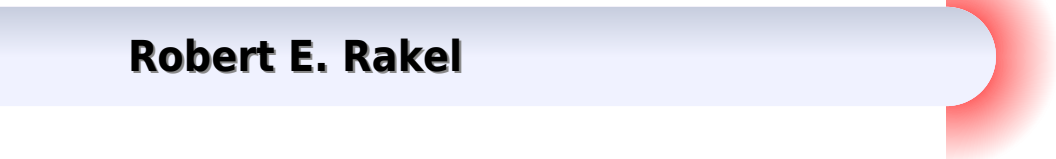
Social
