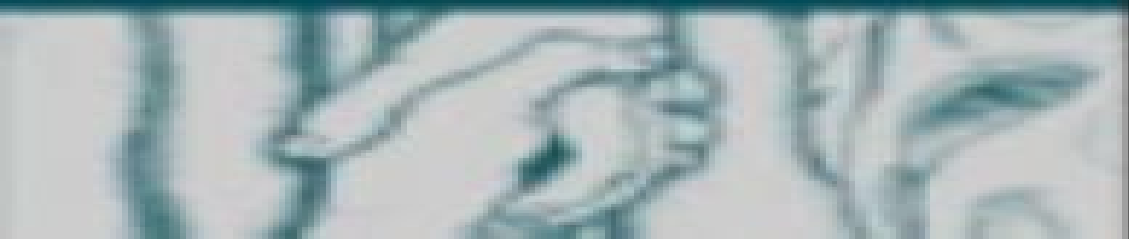

Healing by Hand Servando Z. Hinojosa, 2004 Healing by Hand presents the first cross cultural perspective on manual medicine studies the practice of body therapists that is routinely overlooked by medical practitioners and social scientists The authors describe how manual medicine is one of the primary providers of traditional medicine It takes numerous forms across the world s communities and represents beliefs and practices about healing physical and psychological states and the relation between culture and health This volume is a valuable resource for manual practitioners of western medicine including massage therapists physical therapists chiropractors and osteopaths as well as those with traditional training It is especially recommended for courses such as medical anthropology health and human culture technology and the developing world sociology of health international health and health care systems

Lethal Spots, Vital Secrets Roman Sieler, 2015 Lethal Spots Vital Secrets provides an ethnographic study of varmakalai or the art of the vital spots a South Indian esoteric tradition that combines medical practice and martial arts Although siddha medicine is officially part of the Indian Government s medically pluralistic health care system very little of a reliable nature has been written about it Drawing on a diverse array of materials including Tamil manuscripts interviews with practitioners and his own personal experience as an apprentice Sieler traces the practices of varmakalai both in different religious traditions such as Yoga and Ayurveda and within various combat practices His argument is based on in depth ethnographic research in the southernmost region of India where hereditary medico martial practitioners learn their occupation from relatives or skilled gurus through an esoteric spiritual education system Rituals of secrecy and apprenticeship in varmakalai are among the important focal points of Sieler s study Practitioners protect their esoteric knowledge but they also engage in a kind of lure and withdrawal a performance of secrecy because secrecy functions as what might be called symbolic capital Sieler argues that varmakalai is above all a matter of texts in practice knowledge transmission between teacher and student conveys tacit non verbal knowledge and constitutes a moral economy It is not merely plain facts that are communicated but also moral obligations ethical conduct and tacit bodily knowledge Lethal Spots Vital Secrets is an insightful analysis of practices rarely discussed in scholarly circles It will be a valuable resource to students of religion medical anthropologists historians of medicine Indologists and martial arts and performance studies

The Back Door to Medicine Anderson M. D. Robert Anderson M. D., 2009-10 An anthropologist typically does research by immersing oneself in a society learning the language if need be spending a year or two observing asking questions getting involved photographing videotaping and writing copious notes on how people live their lives in other words on how they experience and manifest their culture Anthropologists call that method participant observation and the goal is to produce a cultural description that can be shared with any and all who might be interested This book describes three cultures in a single integrated narrative For one it offers a case study of the culture of anthropology itself as it records how I experienced ethnographic research as both a method and a way of life My original goal

was to describe the culture of chiropractic as a prominent and important field of alternative medicine As is common in anthropology that seemingly straight forward objective detoured in an unanticipated direction I accomplished my purpose by graduating from a chiropractic college as a Doctor of Chiropractic D C Still another unanticipated diversion in this complex ethnographic adventure led to medical school but not in an accredited institution in the United States Taking a leave of absence from my professorship at Mills College I eventually graduated from a Mexican medical school as a Doctor of Medicine M D I earned qualifications in medicine and surgery by entering the profession through a back door

Maya Bonesetters Servando Z. Hinojosa, 2020-02-28 Scholarship on Maya healing traditions has focused primarily on the roles of midwives shamans herbalists and diviners Bonesetters on the other hand have been largely excluded from conversations about traditional health practitioners and community health resources Maya Bonesetters is the first book length study of bonesetting in Guatemala and situates the manual healing tradition within the current cultural context one in which a changing medical landscape potentially threatens bonesetters work yet presents an opportunity to strengthen its relevance Drawing on extensive field research in highland Guatemala Servando Z Hinojosa introduces readers to a seldom documented though nonetheless widespread variety of healer This book examines the work of Kaqchikel and Tz'utujil Maya bonesetters

analyzes how they diagnose and treat injuries and contrasts the empirical and sacred approaches of various healers Hinojosa shows how bonesetters are carefully adapting certain biomedical technologies to meet local expectations for care and concludes that despite pressures and criticisms from the biomedical community bonesetting remains culturally meaningful and vital to Maya people even if its future remains uncertain
