Canadian Arctic This was also his last exploration Only a few of the men under his command lived to see England again Hudson s expedition was one of great discovery and even greater disaster Extreme Arctic conditions and Hudson s own questionable leadership resulted in the most infamous mutiny in Canadian history and a mystery that remains unsolved
