The words are called irregular because they do not follow the common spelling patterns. For example, the words wood, could, and food has different sounds or spelling patterns. The words food and wood seem five thyring words, but they are not. The words wood and could thyrine, but they do not see the same spoiling pattern. In fact, the word could is an irregular spelled word.

There are many other irregularly spelled words, and many of them are used quite often, instead of learning the sounds of each word, you must learn how to spell the whole word. You sell need to automatically recognize from and metricize how to spell the words.
