They found that the children's outcomes varied considerably while some appeared fully recovered others were severely impaired The size of the study enabled the researchers to identify those factors that most reliably predicted outcome such as early diagnosis continuing convulsions and age at onset of the illness as well as those factors that did not prove predictive of outcome such as sex and social conditions. The researchers also examined the question of whether or not early neurological illness predicted a single syndrome of subsequent impairment.
