Williams, 2023-10-03 In *The Cross of Christ in African American Christian Religious Experience* Piety Politics and Protest Demetrius K Williams examines and explores the ideational importance and rhetorical function of cross language and terminology in Black religious experience through an ideological lens Williams argues that for the first time in Christian history the European nation of Portugal under the guidance of Prince Henry used the theology of the cross to justify and sustain an exclusive trade of Sub Saharan African peoples Claiming that Jesus died on the cross only to save lost souls provided a convincing rational for Henry's exploratory voyages of discovery to West African to exclusively enslave Black

bodies With the confirmation of Catholic Popes and the competition of other European nations this same rationale would inspire empire building colonization and slave trading justified on their newly constructed ideological narrative of compassionate evangelism to save lost souls Over time with massive conversions to the faith of their enslavers Black people s Christian religious experiences would articulate a response to the world that held them in thralldom That response would be articulated most consistently and effectively through their understanding of the cross of Christ Williams affirms Howard Thurman s claim that by some amazing but vastly creative spiritual insight the slave undertook the redemption of a religion that the master had profaned in his midst

African American Religion and the Civil Rights Movement in Arkansas Johnny E. Williams, 2010-12-01 What role did religion play in sparking the call for civil rights Was the African American church a motivating force or a calming eddy The conventional view among scholars of the period is that religion as a source for social activism was marginal conservative or pacifying Not so argues Johnny E Williams Focusing on the state of Arkansas as typical in the role of ecclesiastical activism his book argues that black religion from the period of slavery through the era of segregation provided theological resources that motivated and sustained preachers and parishioners battling racial oppression Drawing on interviews speeches case studies literature sociological surveys and other sources Williams persuasively defines the most ardent of civil rights activists in the state as products of church culture Both religious beliefs and the African American church itself were essential in motivating blacks to act individually and collectively to confront their oppressors in Arkansas and throughout the South Williams explains how the ideology of the black church roused disparate individuals into a community and how the church established a base for many diverse participants in the civil rights movement He shows how church life and ecumenical education helped to sustain the protest of people with few resources and little permanent power Williams argues that the church helped galvanize political action by bringing people together and creating social bonds even when societal conditions made action difficult and often dangerous The church supplied its members with meanings beliefs relationships and practices that served as resources to create a religious protest message of hope

Islam in the African-American Experience Richard Brent Turner, 2003 The involvement of African Americans with Islam reaches back to the earliest days of the African presence in North America This book explores these roots in the Middle East West Africa and antebellum America

African Americans and the Bible Vincent L. Wimbush, 2012-09-01 Perhaps no other group of people has been as much formed by biblical texts and tropes as African Americans From literature and the arts to popular culture and everyday life the Bible courses through black society and culture like blood through veins Despite the enormous recent interest in African American religion relatively little attention has been paid to the diversity of ways in which African Americans have utilized the Bible African Americans and the Bible is the fruit of a four year collaborative research project directed by Vincent L Wimbush and funded by the Lilly Endowment It brings together scholars and experts sixty eight in all from a wide range of academic and artistic fields and disciplines including ethnography cultural history and
