In addition to providing a detailed treatment of the various types of heat exchangers, this part also examines the impact of entropy calculations on exchanger design and operation, maintenance and inspection, OMI plus refractory and insulation effects. The concluding Part of the text examines ABET Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology related topics of concern, including economics and finance, numerical methods, open ended problems, ethics, environmental management and safety, and accident management.
