WHAT IS HEMATOLOGY?

The study (morphology, physiology, and pathology) of blood and blood-forming organs and the diseases thereof

- - As part of a routine medical exam to assess overall health
 - Diagnosis (e.g., an infection, anemia, leukemia)
 - Monitoring of a condition and its treatment.

HEMATOPOIESIS/HEMOPOIESIS

ORGANS OF THE LYMPHATIC SYSTEM

- Bone marrows Modified connective tissue in bone cavities that is soft, fetty, and vascular
 - Red marries: Where blood cells are formed
- Wellipse management Misselly feet. Lymph nodes: Small, widespread organs of the lymphatic system connected by lymphatic vessels. They filter lymph; form lymphocytes; become inflamed/intarged with infection, disease, and injury; and are
- . Tramus plant: Lymphoid organ behind the sternum where T cells are produced and mature, mature T cells imigrate to symph nodes throughout the body. This gland decreases in size with the oncet of
- pulserty and is reptaced with fat. Thympoint Mormone produced by the thymus gland; stimulates T cell development.
- Tensity: Pair of musters of lymphoid tissue located at the root of the tongue in the throat; Micetis on the surface take up antigens (Agi produced by pathogens and stimulate B cetts and T cetts; they also
- Spleen: Largest organ of the lymphatic system, located in the upper left quadrant of the abdomen. It filters blood, including old and damaged red blood crits, and produces lymphocytes.

BLOOD

Delivers propen, nutrients, and hormones to tissues; delivers carbon dioxide to lungs and other waste products to kidneys for removal; blood that leaves the heart returns in 20-30 seconds; there are 5-6 quarts of blood in the human body

COMPONENTS

Red Blood Cells (RBCs)

Also called ergthrecytes, they are non-nucleated, bi-concave discs when mature. They contain Hb, have a 130-day bilespon, and are 6-8 pm diameter birds

- White Blood Cells (WBCs)

Also called bulkocytes, they defend the body against infection. There is -1 WBC for every 600-700 RBCs. GRANULOCYTES

Also called mystorates, they are immune cells containing granules that release ensymes.

- . Basephil: Crit's granules retrease enzymes during an attengic reaction, authors, and an infection. It can be stained by basic dyn, is phopocytic, and has a lifespan of a few hours to a few days.
- Easingphit (acidophit): Crit's granules release engines during an allergic reaction, asshma, and an flection with parasites. It can be stained by acidic dye, is phagocytic, and has a lifespon of 8 to 12 days
- Newtrophil (polymorph): Most numerous WSC, characterized by a dense, must habed nucleus (2-5 latter) and a pole synoplasm with an irregular outline and fine assrophitis granules, which are predominantly secondary (specific) granules (see myelacyte beland. Has a 6 - 20 hour lifespon
 - These precursors, located in bone marrow, sarely occur in normal peripheral blood other than the bond, state, and loverelite florence
 - Myelektast: Also called myelemonoblast, it is the earliest recognizable precurser; characterized by a sarge nucleus with fine chromatin and 2-5 nucleoti, and a cytoptusm with no granules. It varies in size, is capable of cell division, and it gives rise to promyelocyte. Sone marrow comprises less than 5% impeloblasts and it is difficult to distinguish from monoblasts, promonocytes, and monocytes (not enprecyte below):
 - Premyelecyte: Stightly larger than mustablasts, can distinguish commitment to basephilic eccinophilic, and neutraphilic lineages using electron microscopy (EM). Cytoplasm contains primary granules (of bysocomol origin) containing mystoperoxidase (MPC) and other acid hydrolanes, it is: capable of cell division, and gives rice to myelocytes.
 - Myelocyte: Can distinguish morphological commitment to basephilic ecologibilis, and neutrophilis lineages. The nuclear chromatin is more condenced, nucleoti are not visible, and the cytoplasm contains becondary (specific) granules of lysosomol origin containing lactofersin lysosyme, and other enzymes, it is capable of cell division and gives rise to metamoriscyte
 - Metampelocyte: Non-dividing cell. The nucleus is indented or horseshoe-shaped and the cytopiasm contains primary and secondary granules
 - Band, stab, or juvenile: Forms of neutrophili between metamyelocyte and mature neutrophili. They are distinguishable from moture neutrophil by the absence of clear, fine filaments between mortister ligities.

 - Chemotrade: Cell is mobilized and migrates to a foreign material (e.g., bacterium, fungus, debris). or a site of inflammation by chemotactic substances released by damaged tissue, cytokines, and by the interaction of lousocyte adhesion molecules with ligands on damaged tissue
 - Phagocytesis: Ingestion of bacteria, fungi, foreign debris, and dead or damaged host cells
 - Killing and disestion:
 - Oxygen dependent: Superioride, hydrogen peroxide, and other activated oxygen species are generated from dwygen and reduced nigotinamide admine dinucleotide phosphate DANDFVI. Bucteria are killed when hydrogen peroxide reacts with holide and myeloperanidese; process may also involve activated oxygen species.
 - Oxygen-independent: Proteins, such as cathopsin G, lysoxyme (with hydrogen peroxide), or elactase (with Psydrogen peroxide) till bacteria; may also act with a decrease in pH inside a phogacytic vacuals containing bycosomal enzymes. Lactoferrin binds iron, thereby depriving bacteria of iron and generating free radicals (bacteriestatic)
