are many notable Christians who believe that an evolutionary process is in fact how God created life For example BioLogos affirms Evolutionary Creation and asserts God as Creator of all life over billions of years BioLogos was founded by one of the top biologists in the world Francis Collins who led the Human Genome Project 1993 2008 and afterward led the National Institutes of Health But severe defects in Darwinian evolution such as the absence of bona fide transitional fossils and the mystery of biological information contained in DNA decisively points to Intelligent Design rather than a random unguided natural processes in evolution Many Christians reject science even when the scientific evidence is irrefutable simply because the science conflicts with their theology But do they realize that the originator of the Big Bang theory was a Catholic priest Or that the pioneer of modern genetics was an Augustinian monk Or that the decoder of the human genome converted from atheism to Christianity when he was in his 20s Not only that but there are also many notable Christians who believe that God possibly created life by an evolutionary process Or that the earth is many millions of years old I don't think that there's any conflict at all between science today and the Scriptures I think that we have misinterpreted the Scriptures many times and we've tried to make the Scriptures say things they weren't meant to say I think that we have made a mistake by thinking the Bible is a scientific book The Bible is not a book of science The Bible is a book of Redemption and of course I accept the Creation story I believe that God did create the universe I believe that God created man and whether it came by an evolutionary process and at a certain point He took this person or being and made him a living soul or not does not change the fact that God did create man Billy Graham I believe that Christianity can still be believed even if Evolution is true C S Lewis We do not know how remote the period of the creation of this globe may be certainly many millions of years before the time of Adam Our planet has passed through various stages of existence and different kinds of creatures have lived on its surface all of which have been fashioned by God Charles Spurgeon Evidently the conflict between religion and science is not as deep as some may
