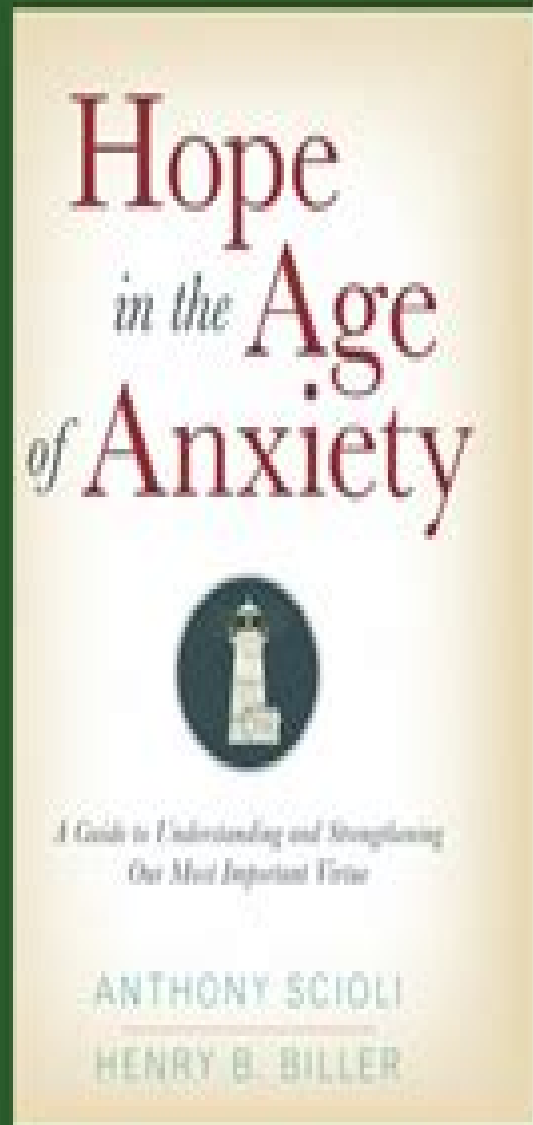

until an anti anxiety drug was created in 1980 The treatment helped the disorder to be added to the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders Now anxiety research is flourishing fMRI technology is even being used to look at how anxiety and parts of the brain are related For example general worries about the future such as when Stossel worries about if his children will be able to pay for college occurs in the frontal lobes of the cerebral
