contains 39 exegetical notes on chapters 1-14 of the Apocalypse which reveal influences of Origen and Didymus the Blind among others. The notes provide spiritual interpretations of the various passages and give attention to the interpretation of certain words that appear in the Book of Revelation. This new translation from the Greek by T. C. Schmidt utilizes all the Greek editions. Furthermore, its introductory matter contains updates on the Scholia from the latest scholarship and compares each scholion with interpretations found in various patristic authors, mainly of Alexandrian heritage. **The Unity of the**

The North Transept of Reims Cathedral, Jennifer M. Feltman, 2016-07-15.
