ALIGNMENT

This attribute moves images, fonts, and objects into alignment and consistency.



BLEED

The part of the page that gets trimmed off once the design is printed.



CAMERA-READY

Media that is designed to ready to be sent to the printer.



CMYK

Color-Printing: Yellow and Magenta. These are colors often used in printing.



CROP MARKS

Guides used to mark where to cut to the final size.



DIE-CUT

Printed items that are cut into shapes or different forms of production.



DPI

How many dots of information can be printed in an inch.



EXPORT

When you export the file, it's a separate file that the user can use without the original file.



FONT

Defines the style and size of characters from information stored in a database.



GIF

Graphics Interchange Format. Used for images, it can either be static or animated.



GRID

Horizontal and vertical lines that intersect and allow a designer to structure content.



GUTTER

The blank space between two pages being sent to print.



JPEG

Joint Photographic Experts Group. A common format for images.



KERNING

The spacing between characters to make the spacing of every two letters work together.



LAYERS

Consists of multiple layers of information, graphics, and images that work together.



LEADING

The vertical space that sits between lines of text.



LOGO DESIGN

The process of creating a visual identity that represents a company, brand, or individual.



MEASURE

Used to define the width of a text block. These options are readability.



NEGATIVE SPACE

The amount of space around the objects and empty space in a design.



OFFSET

A process of printing a document on one side of the page and then printing on the other side of the page.



PANTONE SYSTEM

A color matching system used in the printing industry, developed by Pantone.



PDF

Portable Document Format. A common format for images and documents.



PICA

A unit of measurement used in typography. One pica is 1/6 of an inch.



PIXEL

The smallest element in a digital image. Thousands form an inch.



PMS

Process Color. A color matching system used in the printing industry, developed by Pantone.



PPI

Prints per inch. A measure of resolution. The more PPI the more detailed the image.



PROOF

A stage in printing where you can see what the final product will look like.



PSD

A format used by Photoshop to save files. It's a vector file.



RASTER FILES

These are made up of thousands of small dots that make up each image. They are not scalable.



RGB

Red, Green, and Blue. A color model often used in digital design.



SANS SERIF

Typographic style where letters don't have small lines (serifs) at the end of each character.



SLUG

A space without a character. It's often used to separate text from other elements.



TRACKING

A measure of the space between groups of letters.



TYPEFACE

The style of a font. It's a group of letters that are related in form and style.



TYPOGRAPHY

The art and technique of arranging type to make written language legible and appealing.



VECTOR IMAGES

Images that are made up of mathematical formulas. They are scalable.
