Thomas, 2015-05-05 In the poorest countries such as Afghanistan Haiti and Mali the United States has struggled to work with governments whose corruption and lack of capacity are increasingly seen to be the cause of instability and poverty The development and security communities call for good governance to improve the rule of law democratic accountability and the delivery of public goods and services The United States and other rich liberal democracies insist that this is the only legitimate model of governance Yet poor governments cannot afford to govern according to these ideals and instead are compelled to rely more heavily on older cheaper strategies of holding power such as patronage and repression The unwillingness to admit that poor governments do and must govern differently has cost the United States and others inestimable blood and coin Informed by years of fieldwork and drawing on practitioner work and academic scholarship in politics economics law and history this book explains the origins of poor governments in the formation of the modern state system and describes the way they govern It argues that surprisingly the effort to stigmatize and criminalize the governance of the poor is both fruitless and destabilizing The United States must pursue a more effective foreign policy to engage poor governments and acknowledge how they govern **Reform and Regulation of Economic Institutions in Afghanistan** Haroun Rahimi, 2022-10-21 Taliban's return to power in August of 2021 caused everyone to ask why the two decades of institution building in Afghanistan failed This book investigates the root causes of failed reforms in an important area of reform trade and credit institutions It explains why the efforts to reform and regulate the economic institutions in Afghanistan failed and what we can learn from their failure It draws on more than eighty interviews with Afghan merchants business leaders money dealers and government officials in five major provinces of Afghanistan to identify the barriers to access to credit and to understand the performance of formal institutions banks and their informal counterparts This book finds that Afghan merchants were often unable to benefit from the offerings of formal institutions for three reasons a highly volatile business climate uncertain contract enforcement and an unsupportive property rights system Several informal institutions have emerged that alleviate some of the credit constraints on Afghan merchants These informal institutions include risk sharing trade credit operations money dealers short term working capital loans Gerawee and Sar gufli Although these informal institutions have helped Afghan merchants survive they are unable to support economic growth This book argues that countries like Afghanistan should solve their institutional dilemma by adopting an approach which the author calls Grounded Institutional Reform Using this approach a country would formalize existing informal institutions a development that would vastly increase their effectiveness While this book focuses on credit and trade in Afghanistan the analysis of formalizing the informal can easily be extended to solve other types of economic problems in similarly situated countries This book should be of great interest to scholars policymakers and development workers in the field of law finance Inside Job Mark A. Krasner, 2020-04-07 After generations of foreign policy failures the United States can finally try to make the world safer not by relying on utopian goals but by working pragmatically with nondemocracies Since the end of the Second World War the United States has sunk hundreds of billions of dollars into foreign economies in the hope that its investments would help remake the world in its own image or at the very least make the world safe for democracy So far the returns have been disappointing to say the least Pushing for fair and free elections in undemocratic countries has added to the casualty count rather than taken away from it and trying to eliminate corruption entirely has precluded the elimination of some of the worst forms of corruption In the Middle East for example post 9 11 interventionist campaigns in Afghanistan and Iraq have proved to be long costly and worst of all ineffective Witnessing the failure of the utopian vision of a world full of market oriented democracies many observers both on the right and the left have begun to embrace a dystopian vision in which the United States can do nothing and save no one Accordingly calls to halt all assistance in undemocratic countries have grown louder But as Stephen D Krasner explains this cannot be an option weak and poorly governed states pose a threat to our stability In the era of nuclear weapons and biological warfare ignoring troubled countries puts millions of American lives at risk The greatest challenge for the United States now Krasner writes is to identify a set of policies that lie

between the utopian vision that all countries can be like the United States and the dystopian view that nothing can be done He prescribes a pragmatic new course of policy Drawing on decades of research he makes the case for good enough governance governance that aims for better security better health limited economic growth and some protection of human rights To this end Krasner proposes working with despots to promote growth In a world where a single terrorist can kill thousands or even hundreds of thousands of people the United States does not have the luxury of idealistically ignoring the rest of the world But it cannot remake the world in its own image either Instead it must learn how to make love to despots
