Department of Health and Human Services, Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, 2013-03-21 One of the strengths of systematic reviews is that they aim to include all relevant evidence However study eligibility is often restricted to the English language for practical reasons Google Translate a free Web based resource for translation has recently become available However it is unclear whether its translation accuracy is sufficient for systematic reviews An earlier pilot study provided some evidence that data extraction from translated articles may be adequate but varies by language To address several limitations of the pilot study four
