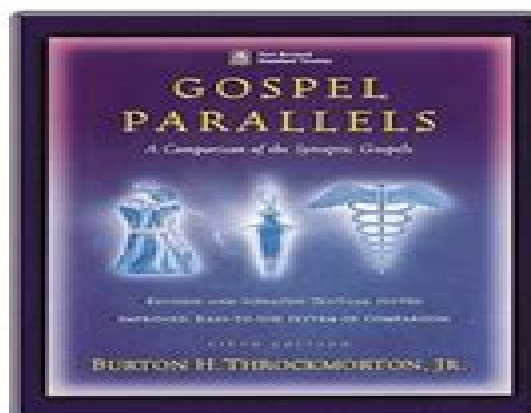

structure of the fundamentalist worldview and the psychology beneath it is pretty much the same across religions It is a controversial thing to say about Christian fundamentalism a thesis that has already proved contentious in the author s public appearances and one that is sure to generate considerable attention and passionate debate as the U S populace continues to divide into opposing camps
