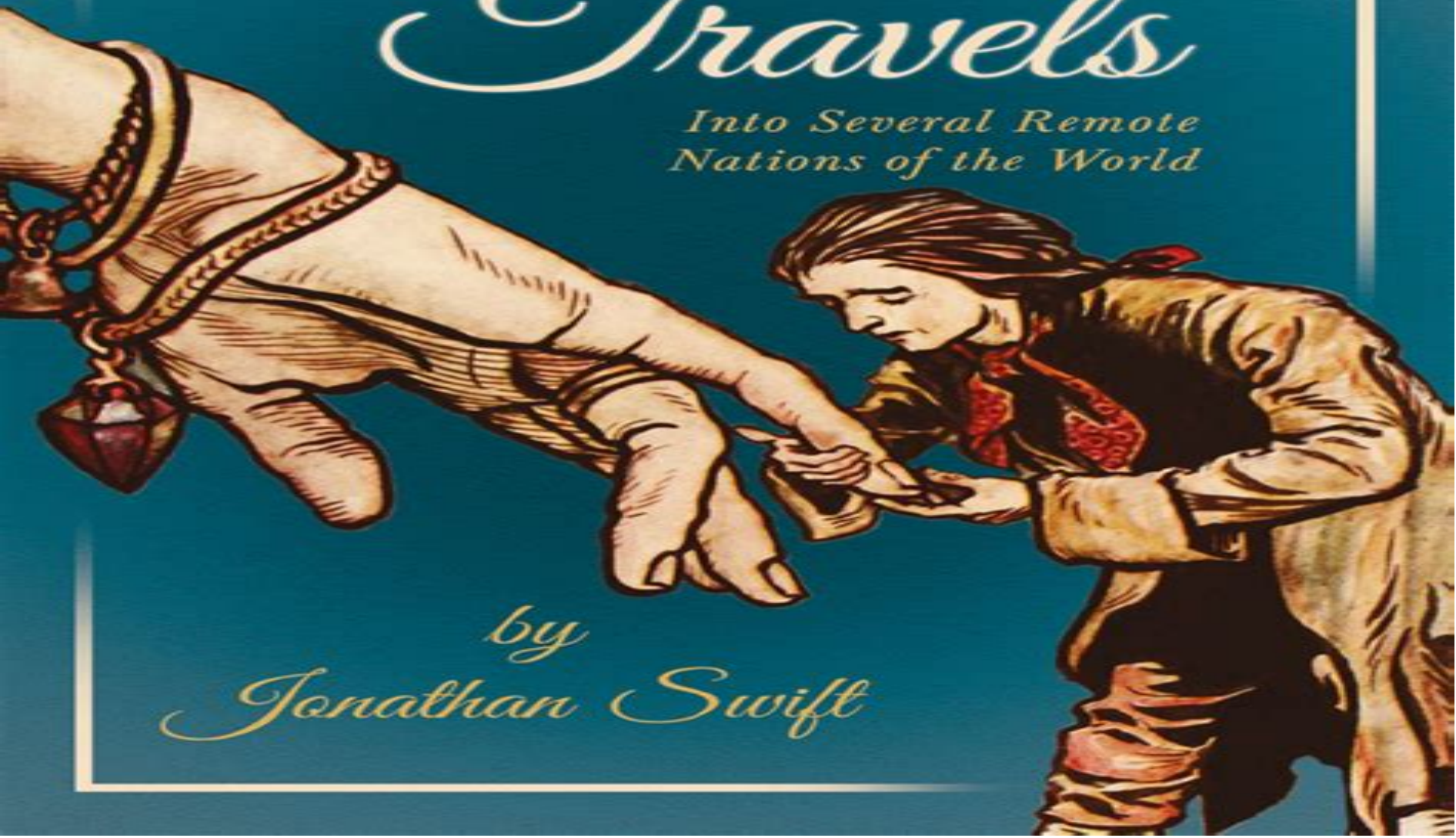

displeasing the King and the court Gulliver is charged with treason for among other crimes making water in the capital though he was putting out a fire and saving countless lives He is convicted and sentenced to be blinded but with the assistance of a kind friend he escapes to Blefuscu Here he spots and retrieves an abandoned boat and sails out to be rescued by a passing ship which safely takes him back home
