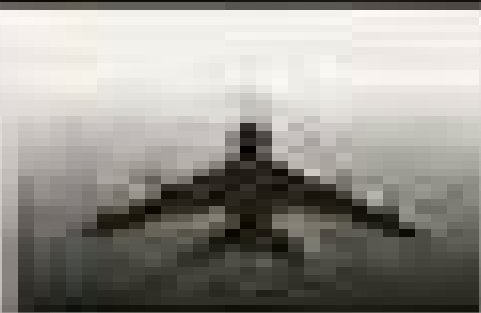

Otterbein, 2004 Have humans always fought and killed each other or did they peacefully coexist until organized states developed Is war an expression of human nature or an artifact of civilization Questions about the origins and inherent motivations of warfare have long engaged philosophers ethicists and anthropologists as they speculate on the nature of human existence In *How War Began* author Keith F Otterbein draws on primate behavior research archaeological research and data gathered from the Human Relations Area Files to argue for two separate origins He identifies two types of military organization one that developed two million years ago at the dawn of humankind wherever groups of hunters met and a second that developed some five thousand years ago in four identifiable regions when the first states arose and proceeded to embark upon military conquests In careful detail Otterbein marshals evidence for his case that warfare was possible and likely among early Homo sapiens He argues from comparison with other primates from Paleolithic rock art depicting wounded humans and from rare skeletal remains embedded with weapon points to conclude that warfare existed and reached a peak in big game hunting societies As the big game disappeared so did warfare only to reemerge once agricultural societies achieved a degree of political complexity that allowed the development of professional military organizations Otterbein concludes his survey with an analysis of how despotism in both ancient and modern states spawns warfare A definitive resource for anthropologists social scientists and historians *How War Began* is written for all who are interested in warfare whether they be military buffs or those seeking to understand the past and the present of humankind Publisher *Acting Alone* Bradley F. Podliska, 2010-03-16 *Acting Alone* A Scientific Study of American Hegemony and Unilateral Use of Force Decision Making is a straight forward analysis of unilateral U S military actions which are dependent upon the power disparity between the U S and the rest of the world In solving the puzzle as to why individual presidents have made the wrong decision to act alone the

author lays out a president's behavior during a crisis as a two step decision process Acting Alone reviews the well studied first decision deciding to use force based on international conflict literature and organized along traditional lines The author then details the second decision deciding to use unilateral force with an explanation of the criticisms of multilateralism and the reasons for unilateralism To test a new theory of unilateral use of force decision making Acting Alone devises a definition and coding rules for unilateral use of force develops a sequential model of presidential use of force decision making and constructs a new alternative measure of military power a Composite Indicator of Military Revolutions CIMR It then uses three methods a statistical test with a heckman probit model an experiment and case studies to test U S crisis behavior since 1937 By applying these three methods the author finds that presidents are realists and make expected utility calculations to act unilaterally or multilaterally after their decision to use force The unilateral decision in particular positively correlates with a wide military gap with an opponent an opponent located in the Western hemisphere and a national security threat

The Post-Cold War International System Ewan Harrison, 2004-07-31 The end of the Cold War has opened up a real world laboratory in which to test and refine general theories of international relations Using the frameworks provided by structural realism institutionalism and liberalism The Post Cold War International System examines how major powers responded to the collapse of the Soviet Union and developed their foreign policies over the period of post Cold War transition The book argues that the democratic peace has begun to generate powerful socialisation effects due to the emergence of a critical mass of liberal democratic states since the end of the Cold War The trend this has produced is similar to a pattern that classical realists have interpreted as bandwagoning within a unipolar power structure Case studies of Germany China and Japan identified as key states with the potential to challenge US dominance provide evidence to support the assessment of international change The author concludes by exploring the implications of September 11th for the analysis developed This important volume argues that the end of the Cold War was a major historical turning point in the development of world politics with fundamental implications for the basic way in which the dynamics of the international system are conceptualised
