One fruitful development in recent research results from the separation of different types of material linked by Wrede in his original study. Since discussion of the Messianic secret involves hypotheses about the origin, purpose and Christology of the Gospel of Mark, the collection serves as a useful survey of Markan studies in the last 25 years. Dr. Tuckett makes it clear that historical questions cannot be ignored since the genre gospel relates kerygma to the historical Jesus, but he thinks that useful insights can be gained by applying the techniques of

literary critics and sociologists, and by examining comparable material (e.g. from Nag
