Their movement extended across the Atlantic as the scholars visited the seat of the Spanish empire to negotiate with the king and his advisors. For social reform, lobbied diverse networks of supporters in Madrid and Peru and struggled for admission to religious orders, schools, and universities and positions in ecclesiastic and civil administration. Indians and Mestizos in the Lettered City explores how scholars contributed to social change and transformation of colonial culture through legal, cultural, and political activism, and how ultimately their significant colonial critiques and campaigns redefined colonial public life and discourse.
