Thus, the book highlights the nexus between human security and development issues. It has two major pillars: one is the development and the other is technology issues. These two interdependent topics are discussed in the perspective of the global pandemic, making this the most important feature of this book. While the world is still in the middle of a pandemic and possibly other natural and biological hazards may affect people's lives and livelihoods in the future, this book provides some key learning which can be used to cope with future uncertainties, including climate risks.
