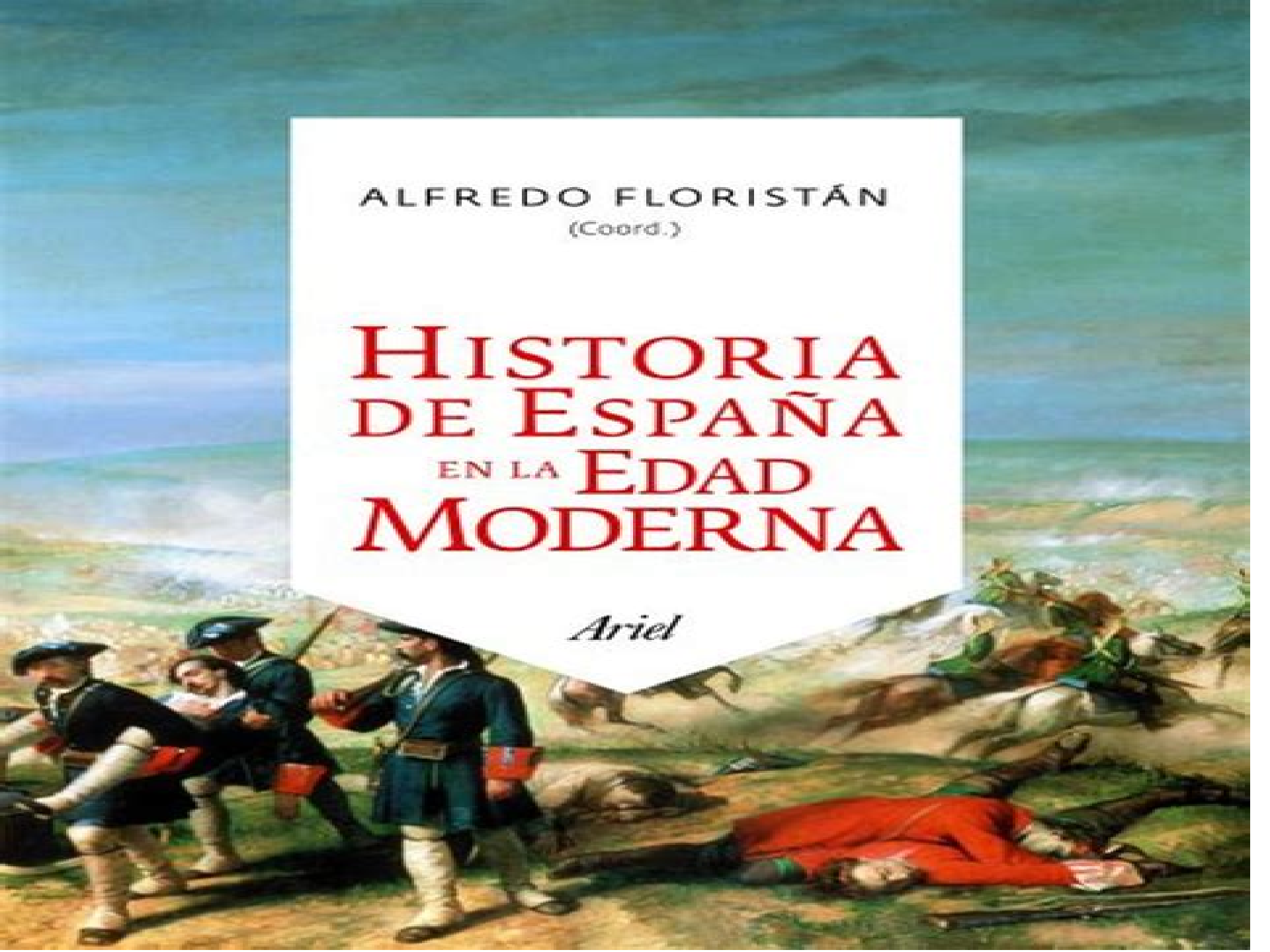

introduces an industrial organisation analysis to the broader structure of Early Modern trade in the Spanish Empire Sitting at the intersection of economic and financial history global history imperial history and political economy this book will be a cutting edge and valuable resource for a broad range of scholars
