

Kennedy and the Cold War

President Kennedy came into office pledged to carry on the Cold War vigorously, but he also hoped for accommodation and was reluctant to commit American power. During his first year-and-a-half in office, he rejected American intervention after the CIA-aided Cuban exile invasion at the Bay of Pigs failed, effectively ended the land-based Southeast Asian nation of Laos to Communist control, and acquiesced in the building of the Berlin Wall. Kennedy's decisions reinforced impressions of weakness that Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev had formed in their only personal meeting, a summit meeting at Vienna in June 1961.

It was against this backdrop that Kennedy faced the most serious event of the Cold War, the Cuban missile crisis.

In the fall of 1962, the administration learned that the Soviet Union was secretly installing offensive nuclear missiles in Cuba. After considering different options, Kennedy decided on a quarantine to prevent Soviet ships from bringing additional supplies to Cuba. He demanded publicly that the Soviets remove the weapons and warned that an attack from that island would bring retaliation against the USSR. After several days of tension, during which the world was closer than ever before to nuclear war, the Soviets agreed to remove the missiles. Critics charged that Kennedy had missed nuclear disaster when such diplomacy might have been effective. But most Americans and much of the non-Communist world applauded his decisions. The missile crisis made him for the first time the acknowledged leader of the democratic West.

In retrospect, the Cuban missile crisis marked a turning point in U.S.-Soviet relations. Both sides saw the need to diffuse tensions that could lead to direct

military conflict. The following year, the United States, the Soviet Union, and Great Britain signed a landmark Limited Test Ban Treaty prohibiting nuclear weapons tests in the atmosphere.

Indochina (Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia), a French possession before World War II, was still another Cold War battlefield. The French effort to recover colonial control there was opposed by Ho Chi Minh, a Vietnamese Communist, whose Viet Minh movement engaged in a guerrilla war with the French army.

Both Truman and Eisenhower, eager to maintain French support for the policy of containment in Europe, provided France with economic aid that freed resources for the struggle in Vietnam. But the French suffered a decisive defeat at Dien Bien Phu in May 1954. At an international conference in Geneva, Laos and Cambodia were given their independence. Vietnam was divided, with Ho in power in the North and Ngo Dinh Diem, a Roman Catholic anti-Communist in a largely Buddhist population, heading the government in the South. Elections were to be held two years later to unify the country. Perceiving that the fall of Vietnam could lead to the fall of Burma, Thailand, and Indonesia, Eisenhower backed Diem's refusal to hold elections in 1956 and effectively established South Vietnam as an American client state.

Kennedy increased assistance, and sent small numbers of military advisors, but a new guerrilla struggle between North and South continued. Diem's popularity grew and the military situation worsened. In late 1963, Kennedy secretly authorized a coup d'état. To the president's surprise, Diem and his powerful brother-in-law, Ngo Dinh Nhu, were killed. It was at this juncture that Kennedy's presidency ended three weeks later.

America Pathways to the Present ,1995 *John F. Kennedy and the Politics of Faith* Patrick Lacroix,2021-01-29 In John F Kennedy and the Politics of Faith Patrick Lacroix explores the intersection of religion and politics in the era of Kennedy s presidency In doing so Lacroix challenges the established view that the postwar religious revival disappeared when President Eisenhower left office and that the contentious election of 1960 which carried John F Kennedy to the White House struck a definitive blow to anti Catholic prejudice Where most studies on the origins of the Christian right trace its emergence to the first battles of the culture wars of the late 1960s and early 1970s echoing the Christian right s own assertion that the secular sixties was a decade of waning religiosity in which faith based groups largely eschewed political engagement Lacroix persuasively argues for the Kennedy years as an important moment in the arc of American religious history Lacroix analyzes the numerous ways in which faith based engagement with politics and politicians efforts to mobilize denominational groups did not evaporate in the early 1960s Rather the civil rights movement major Supreme Court rulings events in Rome and Kennedy s own approach to recurrent religious controversy reshaped the landscape of faith and politics in the period Kennedy lived up to the pledge he made to the country in Houston in 1960 with a genuine commitment to the separation of church and state with his stance on aid to education his willingness to reverse course with the Peace Corps and the Agency for International Development and his outreach to Protestant and Jewish clergy The remarks he offered at the National Prayer Breakfast and in countless other settings had the cumulative effect of diminishing long standing anxieties about Catholic power In his own way Kennedy demanded of Protestants that they live up to their own much vaunted commitment to church state separation This principle could not mean one thing for Catholics and something entirely different for other people of faith American Protestants could not consistently oppose public funding for religious schools because those schools were overwhelmingly Catholic while defending religious exercises in public schools Lacroix reveals how close the country came during the Kennedy administration to a satisfactory solution to the fundamental religious challenge of the postwar years the public accommodation of pluralism as Kennedy came to embrace a nascent religious left that supported his civil rights bill and the nuclear test ban treaty Challenge of Freedom Roger LaRaus,Harry P.
