

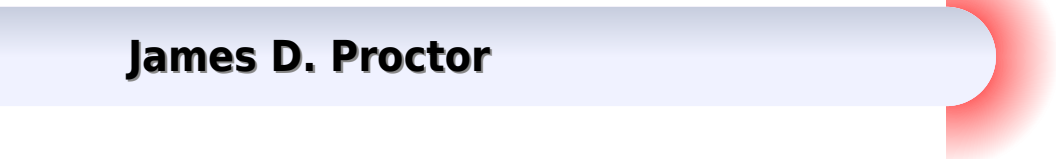

Wallace, John Gach, 2010-04-13 Most of the prefatory issues are extensively elaborated upon in the Prolegomenon which also contains the complete references to the texts and authors discussed below Nevertheless the Preface would be grossly incomplete without touching on some of these issues books and scholars Too many of this book s chapters e g Mora s Marx s D B Weiner s examine and reference important earlier as well as contemporary general histories of psychiatry and specialized monographs in German French Italian and Spanish Also in his 1968 Short History of Psychiatry discussed below Ackerknecht pp xi xii references important nineteenth and earlier twentieth century psychiatric histories in English French and German Such citations will of course not be repeated here Finally thanks to several publishers re editions of dozens of classical psychiatric texts one can consult their bibliographies as well See Prolegomenon for references to these splendid series In a rough and ready sense medical history began in classical Greece for example On Ancient Medicine While traditionally included in the Hippocratic corpus this text seems more likely to have been written by a non or even anti Hippocratic doctor Moreover the Hippocratic and other schools were hardly as secular as we now suppose On Epilepsy for example does not so much declare the prevalent denotation of it as the sacred disease erroneous as it does that it is no more nor less sacred than any other disease

The Bayeux Tapestry John F. Szabo, Nicholas E. Kuefler, 2015-06-18 Commanding its own museum and over 200 years of examination observation and scholarship the monumental embroidery known popularly as the Bayeux Tapestry and

documenting William the Conqueror's invasion of England in October 1066 is perhaps the most important surviving artifact of the Middle Ages. This magnificent textile both celebrated and panned is both enigmatic artwork and confounding historical record. With over 1780 entries Szabo and Kuefler offer the largest and most heavily annotated bibliography on the Tapestry ever written. Notably the Bayeux Tapestry has produced some of the most compelling questions of the medieval period: Who commissioned it and for what purpose? What was the intended venue for its display? Who was the designer and who executed the enormous task of its manufacture? How does it inform our understanding of eleventh century life? And who was the mysterious Aelfgyva depicted in the Tapestry's main register? This book is an effort to capture and describe the scholarship that attempts to answer these questions. But the bibliography also reflects the popularity of the Tapestry in literature covering a surprisingly broad array of subjects. The inclusion of this material will assist future scholars who may study references to the work in contemporary non-fiction and popular works as well as use of the Bayeux Tapestry as a primary and secondary source in the classroom. The monographs, articles, and other works cited in this bibliography reflect dozens of research areas. Major themes are the Tapestry as a source of information for eleventh century material culture, its role in telling the story of the Battle of Hastings and events leading up to the invasion, patronage of the Tapestry, biographical detail on known historical figures in the Tapestry, arms and armor, medieval warfare strategy and techniques, *opus anglicanum*, the Anglo-Saxon needlework tradition, preservation and display of the artifact, the Tapestry's place in medieval art, the embroidery's depiction of medieval and Romanesque architecture, and the life of the Bayeux Tapestry itself.

Freedom's Progress?
Gerard Casey, 2021-10-04

In *Freedom's Progress* Gerard Casey argues that the progress of freedom has largely consisted in an intermittent and imperfect transition from tribalism to individualism from the primacy of the collective to the fragile centrality of the individual person and of freedom. Such a transition, he argues, is neither automatic nor complete, nor are relapses to tribalism impossible. The reason for the fragility of freedom is simple: the importance of individual freedom is simply not obvious to everyone. Most people want security in this world, not liberty. Libertarians writes Max Eastman used to tell us that the love of freedom is the strongest of political motives, but recent events have taught us the extravagance of this opinion. The herd instinct and the yearning for paternal authority are often as strong. Indeed, the tendency of men to gang up under a leader and submit to his will is of all political traits the best attested by history. The charm of the collective exercises a perennial magnetic attraction for the human spirit. In the 20th century Fascism, Bolshevism, and National Socialism were, Casey argues, each of them a return to tribalism in one form or another, and many aspects of our current Western welfare states continue to embody tribalist impulses. Thinkers you would expect to feature in a history of political thought feature in this book: Plato, Aristotle, Machiavelli, Locke, Mill, and Marx, but you will also find thinkers treated in *Freedom's Progress* who don't usually show up in standard accounts: Johannes Althusius, Immanuel Kant, William Godwin, Max Stirner, Joseph Proudhon, Mikhail Bakunin, Pyotr Kropotkin, Josiah Warren, Benjamin Tucker, and Auberon Herbert. *Freedom's Progress* also contains

discussions of the broader social and cultural contexts in which politics takes its place with chapters on slavery Christianity the universities cities Feudalism law kingship the Reformation the English Revolution and what Casey calls Twentieth Century Tribalisms Bolshevism Fascism and National Socialism and an extensive chapter on human prehistory
