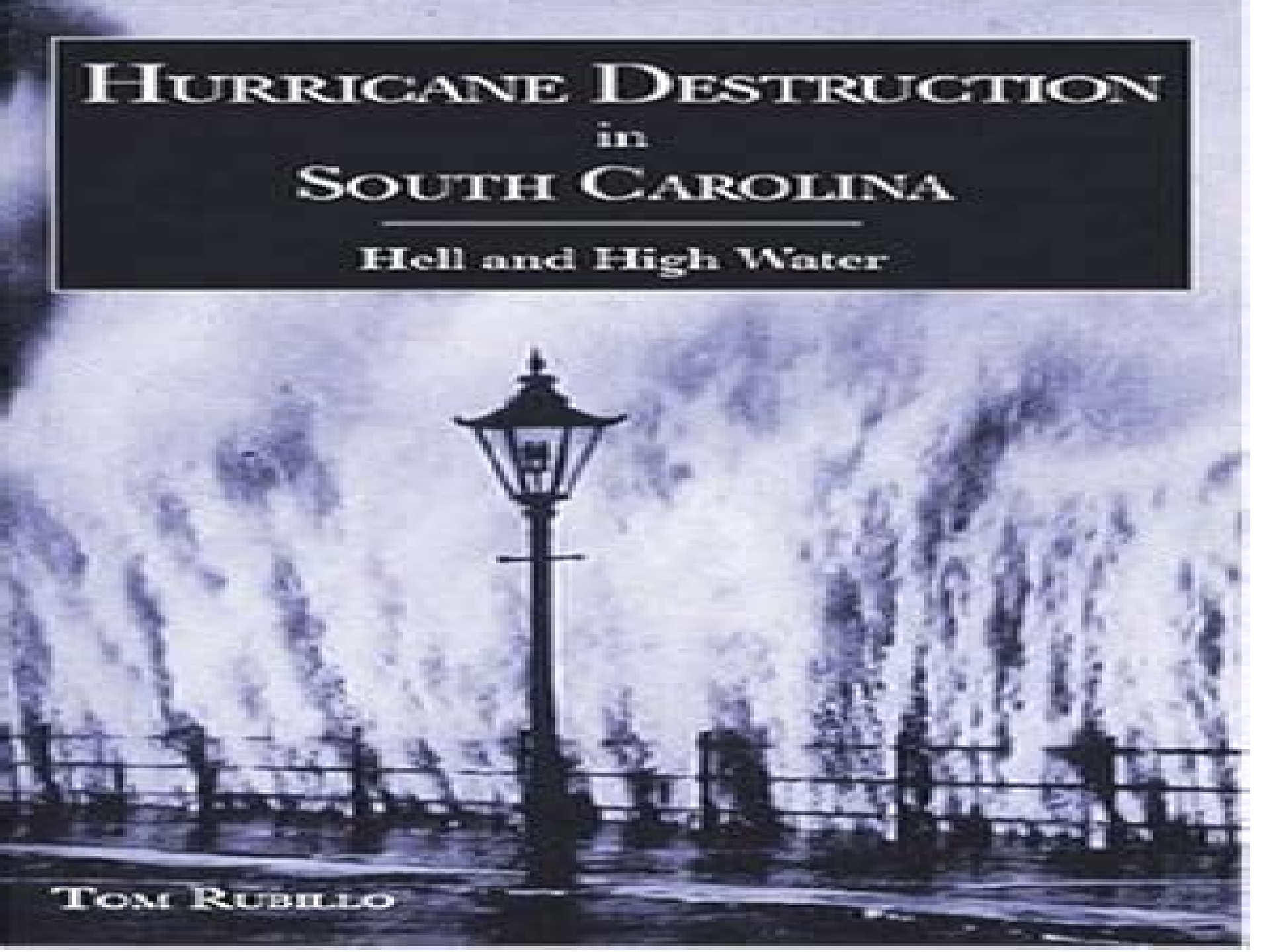

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Hurricane Destruction in South Carolina Tom Rubillo, 2006-06-01 In late September 1989 South Carolina was rocked by the colossal force of Hurricane Hugo A category four hurricane Hugo devastated the coast and other regions of the state claiming dozens of lives and causing billions of dollars in damage Hugo was the Palmetto States most destructive natural disaster in recent memory but the story of that storm is only part of the larger history of hurricanes in South Carolina A History of Hurricane Destruction in South Carolina Hell and High Water examines more than thirty major hurricanes that have struck the state since the 1800s offering a revealing look at the destruction and loss that results from these violent manifestations of natures power Author Tom Rubillo brings to bear a breadth of research and incorporates first person accounts of the storms and the struggle of survivors forced to rebuild in the wake of tremendous losses Hell and High Water is at once a history of the damage wrought by the fury of hurricanes and a reminder that the next great storm could be no more than a season away

Navin,2022-04-13 The compelling story of a colony besieged by meteorological epidemiological economic and manmade catastrophes only to arise like the phoenix Orville Vernon Burton author of The Age of Lincoln During South Carolina s settlement a cadre of men rose to political and economic prominence while ordinary colonists enslaved Africans and indigenous groups became trapped in a web of violence and oppression John J Navin explains how eight English aristocrats the Lords Proprietors came to possess the vast Carolina grant and then enacted elaborate plans to recruit and control colonists as part of a grand moneymaking scheme But those plans went awry and the mainstays of the economy became hog and cattle ranching lumber products naval stores deerskin exports and the calamitous Indian slave trade The settlers relentless pursuit of wealth set the colony on a path toward prosperity but also toward a fatal dependency on slave labor Rice would produce immense fortunes in South Carolina but not during the colony s first fifty years Religious and political turmoil instigated by settlers from Barbados eventually led to a total rejection of proprietary authority Using a variety of primary sources Navin describes challenges that colonists faced setbacks they experienced and the effects of policies and practices initiated by elites and proprietors Storms fires epidemics and armed conflicts destroyed property lives and dreams Threatened by the Native Americans they exploited by the Africans they enslaved and by their French and Spanish rivals South Carolinians lived in continual fear For some it was the price they paid for financial success But for most there were no riches and the possibility of a sudden violent death was overshadowed by the misery of their day to day existence [Lines of Scrimmage](#) Joe Oestreich,Scott Pleasant,2015-08-14 As in many small towns in the South folks in Conway South Carolina fill the stands on fall Fridays to cheer on their local high school football squad In 1989 with returning starter Carlos Hunt at quarterback and having finished with an 8 4 record in 1988 hopes were high that the beloved Tigers would win their first state championship But during spring practice Coach Chuck Jordan who is white benched Hunt who is black in favor of Mickey Wilson an inexperienced white player Seeing this demotion of the black quarterback as an example of the racism prevalent in football generally and in Conway specifically thirty one of the team s thirty seven black players under the guidance of H H Singleton pastor of Cherry Hill Missionary Baptist Church and president of the local NAACP boycotted the team in protest The season long strike severed the town along racial lines as it became clear that the incident was about much more than football It was about the legacy of slavery and segregation and Jim Crow and other points of tension and oppression that many people in Conway and the South had wrongly assumed were settled While the 1989 season is long over the story reverberates today Chuck Jordan is still coaching at Conway High and he s still without that state

championship Meanwhile Mickey Wilson is now coaching Conway's fiercest rival the Myrtle Beach Seahawks In the annual Victory Bell Game between Conway and Myrtle Beach the biggest contest of the year for both teams a veteran coach and his young protégé compete against each other against the backdrop of a racial conflict that bitterly divided a small southern town

Tinicum & Eastwick Will Caverly, 2024-12-31 When plans to overhaul Southwest Philadelphia in the 1950s scheduled both the integrated neighborhood of Eastwick and the ecologically valuable Tinicum marshes to be razed two grassroots movements took up the cause battling eminent domain in the name of environmental conservation and economic injustice In the 1950s city planners eager to change the face of Philadelphia had designs on the city's southwest They planned to raze the integrated neighborhood of Eastwick and level the ecologically valuable Tinicum marshlands to make room for a new city within a city In response two grassroots movements began a resistance that spanned decades battling eminent domain in the name of environmental conservation and economic injustice The Eastwick neighborhood's resistance to the project was racially diverse and working class in nature Led by housewives they went toe to toe with a government bureaucracy hungry for progress As Eastwick rallied to defend itself a parallel grassroots effort by bird watchers desperately worked to save the embattled Tinicum marshes These unspoiled remains of Pennsylvania's last freshwater tidal marsh were home to hundreds of threatened species of wildlife Amid protest marches and bomb threats political intrigue and outrage a question emerged that would forever influence the region Who deserves a home wildlife or human beings Through oral history and exhaustive research *Tinicum Eastwick* documents one of the most egregious civil rights violations in Pennsylvania history as well as one of the state's greatest environmental triumphs Author Will Caverly confronts the intersection of eminent domain and environment told through the struggles everyday residents of Southeastern Pennsylvania endured to pursue justice

Asylum Doctor Charles S. Bryan, 2014-05-27 This biography of an early twentieth century South Carolina doctor sheds light on his pioneering work with the mentally ill to combat a public health scourge Thousands of Americans died of pellagra before the cause vitamin B3 deficiency was identified Credit for solving the mystery is usually given to Dr Joseph Goldberger of the US Public Health Service But in *Asylum Doctor* Charles S Bryan demonstrates that a coalition of American asylum superintendents local health officials and practicing physicians set the stage for Goldberger's historic work chief among them was Dr James Woods Babcock As superintendent of the South Carolina State Hospital for the Insane from 1891 to 1914 Babcock sounded the alarm against pellagra He brought out the first English language treatise on the subject and organized the National Association for the Study of Pellagra He did so in the face of troubled asylum governance which coupled with Governor Cole Blaise's political intimidation and unblushing racism eventually drove Babcock from his post *Asylum Doctor* describes the plight of the mentally ill in South Carolina during an era when public asylums had devolved into convenient places to warehouse inconvenient people It is the story of an idealistic humanitarian who faced conditions most people would find intolerable And it is important social history for as this book's epigraph puts it in many ways the Old South died with the
