championship Meanwhile Mickey Wilson is now coaching Conway s fiercest rival the Myrtle Beach Seahawks In the annual Victory Bell Game between Conway and Myrtle Beach the biggest contest of the year for both teams a veteran coach and his young prot g compete against each other against the backdrop of a racial conflict that bitterly divided a small southern town
