The hospitality industry requires a large volume of data to run day-to-day business operations and to achieve excellent service delivery. Unlike other industries, hospitality is a service-based industry that relies upon an ability to form relations with a customer base (Kokaz Pucciani and Murphy, 2011). As a result, the industry is reliant upon information about consumers and their preferences. These preferences may range from preferred room type to information about personal needs.
